

Congruent with its original charge and timetable, the General Education Task Force (GETF) aims to achieve the following goals for the 2017-2108 academic year:

Late August-September 2017

- Draft mission statement for General Education congruent with campus mission and strategic plan
- Formulate 6-8 overall goals for General Education, which organize and summarize the comprehensive draft of learning outcomes for General Education produced by the GETF in the Spring 2017 term, congruent with LEAP and faculty/student priorities
- Complete drafts of three distinct plans for a comprehensive, revised General Education curriculum
- Discuss and revise these in our initial fall term General Education Task Force meetings

Late September 2017

- Present mission/goals/outcomes to the Senate General Education Committee for feedback and revision
- Begin exploration of assessment vehicles useful for these (e-portfolios, rubrics, etc.); finalize an initial draft outline for an assessment plan for General Education

October 2017

- Present mission and goals to Academic Senate and/or various faculty groups for feedback and revision
- Make public three comprehensive draft plans for revised General Education curriculum to begin process of public discussion and feedback
- Discuss assessment vehicles and how to integrate them into General Education with various campus constituencies, beginning with the Senate General Education Committee, etc.

November/December 2017

- Finish three draft models for General Education, after revising the initial drafts based on comments and feedback from various campus constituencies

January 2018

- Present the three draft models to the various academic units and student focus groups for final revisions

February 2018

- Revise draft models to present to the Academic Senate based on these discussions, after consultation with General Education Committee and other relevant faculty committees
- Complete outline of a comprehensive assessment plan for General Education, based on discussions of earlier drafts

March 2018

- Consult with faculty and faculty committees on how to implement specific assessment procedures for General Education

April 2018

- **Vote in the Academic Senate to select and adopt one of the revised General Education models with integrated assessment as the new General Education curriculum**
- Finalize basic details of the outline assessment plan for General Education based on the particular curriculum adopted by the Academic Senate

Future goals:

- The comprehensive, integrated assessment plan will need to be finalized by inclusion of particular *measures* and *procedures* that are specific to the General Education curriculum adopted in April 2018
