### Constitution of The Tiến lên-Euchre Club

## Preamble

The Tiến lên-Euchre Club aims to bring together students, both domestic and international, who enjoy the card games of Euchre, popular in the American Midwest, and Tiến lên, popular in Vietnam.

## Article I: Membership

Those who would like to join or leave the Tiến lên-Euchre Club should feel free to do so at any time. This can be done through email to the club's President. Members are expected to attend at least one meeting a semester to continue to be considered an active member of the club. If a member is acting toxic (rude, negative, etc.) at meetings, the President will step in and converse with said member to help reduce this behavior. If their behavior continues afterwards, the member will be asked to leave the meeting and will be removed from the club.

## Article II: University Compliance

**This organization shall comply with all Indiana University regulations, and local, state and federal laws.**

## Article III: Executive Officers

The head executive officer is the President. The President must lead, organize, and plan all club meetings. In addition to this, the President must take charge of all activities regarding members joining/leaving and advertising the club. The President will be assisted by two Vice Presidents and a Treasurer. The roles of the Vice Presidents are to help guide the President in making decisions in anything regarding the club. The Treasurer will be responsible for the club's funding matters. These executive members will serve until graduation, where their vacancies will be filled through a popular vote that takes place on the last club meeting of the year. Executive members are to resign by sending an official email through the club's email list, and their vacancies will be filled by popular vote at the following club meeting. As with general members, the President will first talk with an officer if they are being toxic. If the behavior continues, they will then be asked to leave the meeting and will be removed from the club.

## Article IV: Advisor

The advisor will be selected by the President and will help with making executive decisions. It is expected that the Advisor and President will regularly keep in contact about club matters. The Advisor is not required to attend any club meetings but is more than welcome to. Although unanticipated, the Advisor will be removed if they stop communicating with and can no longer be reached (via email) by the President. To search for a new advisor the President will consult the officers and members to determine a possible replacement. An email will then be sent to

the potential new Advisor and will include a description of the club and will outline the expectations for the Advisor.

#### Article V: Meetings

Meetings will take place once a week at a time and place decided on at the beginning of each semester. Meetings will consist of playing/teaching the two card games and will cover any club business.

#### Article VI: Elections

Elections will take place in advance of the graduation of an officer on the last club meeting of the semester. Elections will be decided by popular vote through a simple form sent via email, and those wishing to run for officer should do so by emailing the President. The quorum for a valid election is 25% of the club (including both members and officers).

#### Article VII: Non-Hazing

**Hazing is strictly prohibited. Hazing shall be defined as any conduct which subjects another person, whether physically, mentally, emotionally, or psychologically, to anything that may endanger, abuse, degrade, or intimidate the person as a condition of association with a group or organization, regardless of the person's consent or lack of consent.**

#### Article VIII: Dues & Budgets

There are two main sections to the budget: recruitment and entertainment. Recruitment is focused around attracting potential new members through fliers and other forms of advertisement. Entertainment includes food and drink at club meetings. The budget is subject to change and is managed by the Treasurer. All financial expenditures must be approved by the President. No dues are required by members.

#### Article IX: Finances

Any financial matters that arise will be dealt with by the Treasurer. It is expected that the Treasurer keeps the President updated on financial matters. If the club were to dissolve, the remaining money will be donated to a registered charity of choice.

#### Article X: Personal Gain Clause

**This organization, if raising funds, shall ethically raise and distribute profits from organizational functions to either the organization or to members who provide a service that directly benefits the organization. Individual members may not receive compensation from for-profit companies if acting as a representative of a student organization.**

#### Article XI: Amendments

Members will be notified of proposed amendments through email. All members are required to submit a vote on proposed amendments. Votes will be complete through a form sent via email.
