

This report illustrates financial aid awarded to students who enrolled at time of census in any of the academic terms that comprise the fiscal year of 2006-07, who received a degree in the 2006-07 fiscal year, or who completed a correspondence course in the 2006-07 fiscal year. The financial aid figures represent disbursed aid⁵ for the 2006-07 academic year and 2007 summer term (2006-07 "aid year"). All IU campuses are included other than Fort Wayne.

Please note the following changes from the 2005-2006 Report: AmeriCorps benefits are included in federal gift aid, rather than included with work study; work study figures represent work performed in fall 2006, spring 2007, or summer 2007, rather than all historical work that had financial activity between July 1, 2006 and June 30, 2007; IU endowed and IU Foundation gift aid is reported as institutional, rather than private.

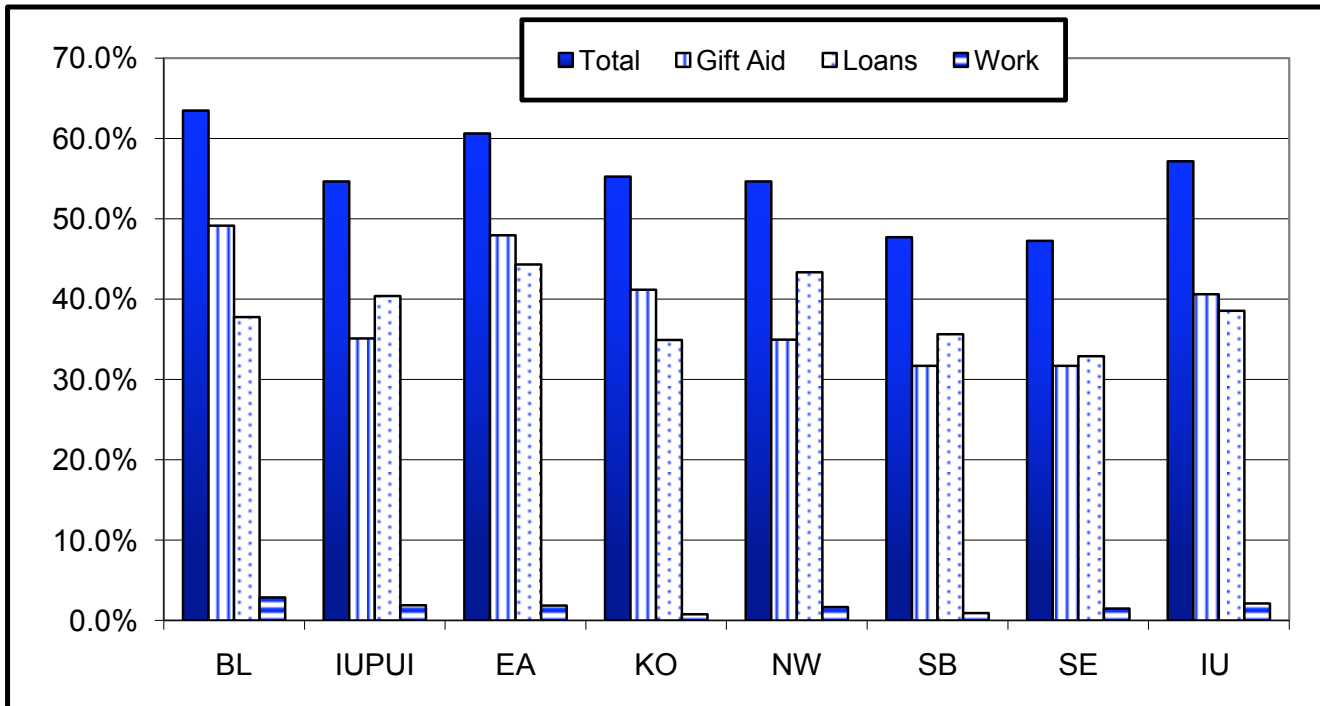

Other Indiana State Aid	Hoosier, Nursing, and Minority Scholarships, Vocational Rehabilitation Awards, CVO Grants funded by the State of Indiana, Indiana National Guard Supplemental Grants, and student funding from research grants funded by the State of Indiana.
Other Institutional Funds	Funds from IU Auxiliary units, as well as awards that are not predominantly funded by any of the other institutional categories: general funds, IU/IUF matching funds, IU Foundation funds, or IU endowed funds.
Other Need-based Federal Loans	Nursing and Health Professions Loans (excluding PCL Super loans, which function as consolidation loans).
Other Private Gift Aid	Awards which are disbursed through Indiana University such as service club scholarships (e.g. Kiwanis, Rotary, etc.), research grants funded by private foundations, and funding from other state and foreign governments.
Private Loans	Various private loan programs, including Opportunity and Signature loans.
Veterans Benefits	Total benefit under all federal Veterans Benefit Programs including VA Contributory Benefits, GI Bill, and Dependent's Educational Assistance.

Appendix

- A-1 Only includes students who enrolled at time of census in any of the academic terms that comprise the fiscal year of 2006-07, who received a degree in the 2006-07 fiscal year, or who completed a correspondence course during the fiscal year.
- A-2 Non-degree, high school, and not-reported
- A-3 Reciprocity included in resident.
- A-4 Dependency is determined from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Unknown dependency status is excluded.
- A-5 Disbursed aid includes federal and state work study amounts paid through the IU labor ledger, including the employer's share and work-study program share, as well as gift aid and loan amounts disbursed in the IU Student Information System. Also included are several categories of aid that are recorded but not paid through the IU Student Information System. These categories include federal veterans educational benefits and IU athletic book scholarships. Students' aid amounts represent a snapshot of financial aid taken on August 31, 2007.
- A-6 The unduplicated count of aid recipients divided by the total number of all students reported to the Commission.
- A-7 Student counts of 1 through 10 are masked with ***.
- A-8 Total University counts of students represent the sum of each campus' unduplicated enrollment. Example: If a student enrolls at both Bloomington and IUPUI, the student is counted twice.
- A-9 All aid for students on a financial aid consortium agreement is reported on the student's home campus for that academic term.
