


The purpose of this Articulation agreement is to provide a framework for the effective transfer of Vincennes University (VU) Behavioral Sciences – Sociology Option (A.A.) students to continue their professional education in the Sociology (B.A.) at Indiana University - Kokomo (IUK). The students who follow the VU curriculum have indicated their intent to continue their education in order to complete the requirements for the baccalaureate program in Sociology.

To ensure the smooth transition to the proposed baccalaureate program at IUK, the faculty of both institutions, have developed the attached listing of course equivalencies approved for transfer for students beginning their programs at either institution. This listing has been identified as Part I of the agreement. Part I identifies each course in the VU curriculum and how it will appear on the student's official IUK transcript upon completion of the transfer. Part II lists the courses that VU graduates from the A.A. in Behavioral Sciences – Sociology Option would expect to complete as part of their B.A. degree after transferring to IUK as "rising juniors". In order to benefit from this 2+2 program agreement, VU students must complete the AA degree with a sufficient grade point to be accepted into the IUK program. To ensure consistency and accuracy, these documents must be periodically reviewed by representatives from both institutions to communicate and update information regarding curriculum and textbooks. In addition, only courses with a grade of "C" or above in the major requirements will be transferred and credited toward the baccalaureate degree.

All course work taken prior to Fall 2007 will be evaluated by IUK program faculty in order to determine transferability of the course work. The Articulation Agreement, including any modifications, will be reviewed and updated in three years from the effective date of the agreement. Further, it is expected that both institutions will keep the other party aware of all curriculum changes as they occur.
