As We See Them presents the work of eleven international photographic artists who are using 19th century Alternative Processes to create contemporary photographs which image sexuality and the human figure. Guest curators are photographers Herbert Ascherman, Jr. and Jeannette Palsa from Cleveland, Ohio. Featured works include cyanotypes by Patrick Alt and Charles West, platinum-palladium prints by Herbert

Ascherman Jr. and Jeannette Palsa, gum bichromate prints by Laurent Benaïm, photogravures by Constantine Gedal, tintypes by Cynthia Greig, ambrotypes by Ed Ross, daguerreotypes by Charlie Schreiner, and aluminum-types by Mark Sink and Kristen Hatgi.
