- I. Minutes of November 10, 2009, meeting approved.**
- II. New Course Request – BUS-K312 Decision Modeling**
This course was originally submitted to the curriculum committee as BUS-K400 but issues regarding overlap with MATH courses caused the proposal to be tabled. Marcy Jance me with members of the math department and all agreed that the decision modeling course would be better numbered as K312. The BUS-K312 course was approved by the committee 7-0, and will be presented to the agenda committee as a voting item.
- III. New Course Request – MUS-K140 Music Notation Workshop**
The MUS-K140 course was approved by the committee 7-0 and will be presented to the agenda committee as a voting item.
- IV. New Course Request – MUS-K431 Electronic and Computer Music II**
Line 15 of the New Course Request Form read, “Jacobs does not want to offer MUS-K404 which this course will replicate,” was changed to, “This course fits as the third course in a three semester sequence of electronic music.” The MUS-K140 course was approved by the committee 7-0, and will be presented to the agenda committee as a voting item.
- V. New Course Request – MUS-M250 Introduction to Music Research and Analysis**
The MUS-M250 course was approved by the committee 7-0, and will be presented to the agenda committee as a voting item.
- VI. New Course Request – MUS-M251 Introduction to Musicology**
The original New Course Request Form submitted incorrectly noted that MUS-450 was a prerequisite. The typo was corrected to read MUS-M250 as a prerequisite. The MUS-M251 course was approved by the committee 7-0, and will be presented to the agenda committee as a voting item.

VII. New Program Request – B.A. in Natural Science and Mathematics: Online Degree Completion Track.

The New Program Request was approved by the committee 7-0, and will be presented to the agenda committee as a voting item.

VIII. Computer Literacy Policy

Based on feedback from faculty the committee unanimously agree that the existing computer literacy policy should be rescinded because it is outdated and has essentially been replaced with computer literacy guidelines contained in the current Framework for General Education. Bob Ramsey will prepare a resolution for approval by the committee at its next meeting.

IX. Institutional Degree Requirements – Minimum “C” requirement.

The committee agreed to continue to review the “Minimum-C” grade requirement contained in the IU East Institutional Program Requirements. After further discussion with faculty and administration this issue will again be discussed at the next meeting.
