Re: ACA-56 and 82 on Transfer Credits

A. The UFC Policy Review Committee has reviewed ACA-82, Transfer Credit From an Associate's College Applied to an Indiana University Baccalaureate Degree; and ACA-56, Transfer of Credit Completed at the 100 and 200 Level; and finds:

1. The faculty have primary legislative authority over policies determining academic credit for students under the Constitution, but that authority is shared with university administrators and limited by state law.
2. The UFC enacted a policy on whether transfer credits could satisfy departmental requirements or transfer above the 200 level in 2016, and this revision does not make any changes to that policy.
3. Because these policies overlap, consolidation into a single policy was appropriate.

B. The policy update proposal has been circulated for comment.

The amendment has been developed in consultation with the university chief policy officer and the university transfer office, circulated to campus academic affairs officers, UFC co-chairs, and campus council presidents.

C. The Committee moves that the UFC take the following actions:

1. Amend ACA-56 to read as shown in the accompanying document, ACA56-Transfer Credit From an Associate's College
2. Rescind ACA-82
