1. IUSB Forum: Starting Sunday, Feb. 14, a weekly television program produced by Indiana University at South Bend will be shown on WSBT-TV, Channel 22.

Called "IUSB Forum," the series will draw on the resources of this institution and focus on issues of contemporary interest -- in and out of higher education. Normally, "Forum" will be a half-hour program early on Sunday afternoons. Occasionally it will be shortened to 15 minutes and it may sometimes run on Saturday rather than Sunday.

This Sunday's inaugural program will start at 1:30 p.m. Dr. Earl J. Savage, Biology, and Dr. Lawrence L. Garber, Chemistry, will discuss biological and chemical aspects of pollution.

2. Tax Credit: For the enlightenment of do-it-yourself taxpayers, we call attention to the existence of Indiana Tax Form CC-40. That's the form which lets Indiana taxpayers who contributed last year to Indiana University or other in-state colleges and universities, public or private, claim a credit on their state adjusted gross income tax.

The law provides for a credit of 50 per cent of the aggregate amount of contributions made per taxpayer to institutions of higher education in Indiana -- up to a limit of \$50 in the case of a single return or \$100 in the case of a joint return. The distinction between a credit and a deduction is important: A deduction reduces taxable income, but a credit is subtracted from the actual tax liability.

Form CC-40 is not part of the package Indiana taxpayers got from the Indiana Department of Revenue. It can be obtained from the local office of the department at 2015 W. Western Avenue.
