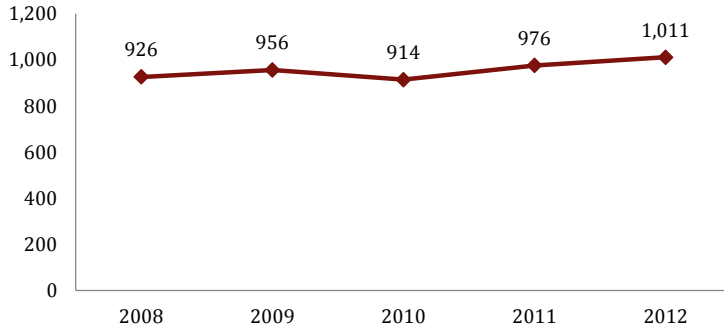
Completions By Age

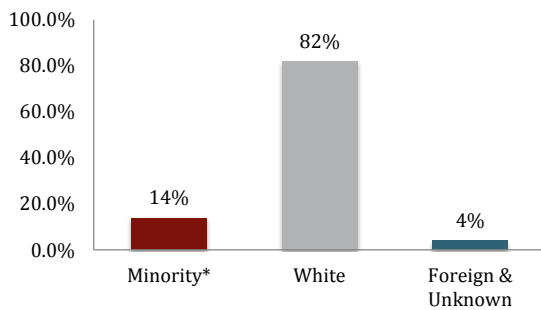

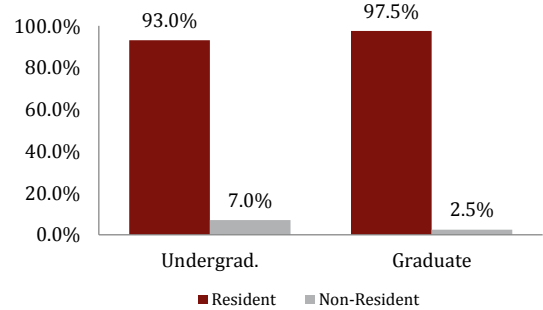
