On May 31st Alex Wenner retired from the IU Libraries after 27 years of monographic cataloging. From 1982 -1986 Alex participated as a cataloger in three Title IIC grant projects: Three Centuries of English and American Drama, 1500-1830; Wing STC – short title catalog (Early English Books, 1641-1700; and, Retrospective conversion of the IU folklore collection. From 1986 until his retirement, Alex specialized in cataloging monographs for materials in English and West European languages. Alex was fluent in German and had strong language skills in French, Italian and Russian. He was self-taught in Russian, which he periodically cataloged throughout his career at IU. Alex took great pride in facilitating rush cataloging requests, as he monitored the rush email, usually cataloging the books himself. Our thanks to Alex for many years of excellent cataloging and national-level authority work!

SirsiDynix rollover of acquisition records to fiscal year 2010 will commence the last week of June. To accommodate rollover, we ask that you not work in the Acquisition or Serial Control module of WorkFlows beginning June 27th. A notice will be sent to all library staff when rollover has been completed. All work with orders, funds, and vendors, including display mode and read-only access should cease during rollover. Cataloging is not affected by rollover. Order links in bibliographic records should not be altered. Serials check-in should cease. A document that identifies the specific activities not allowed during rollover is available on the intranet at
