The planning committee invites presentation proposals for the 2016 Statewide Libraries Day. This year Statewide Libraries Day will focus on Innovations and Transformations! Presentations will be categorized under three tracks:

- Innovations and Research: Programs included in this track will highlight projects and research that aim to improve the processes and services that make IU Libraries great! Some examples are: Collaborative projects with faculty and staff outside the library; new workflow processes; subject research; library science related research; and innovative programming in our libraries.
- Project Management: Programs included in this track will focus on improving participants' skills related to project design, implementation and outcomes. Some examples are: Making project management tools work for you; pitching your project to leadership; promoting your project; and evaluating the results.
- Research Design: Programs included in this track will focus on improving participants' research design and publication skills. Some examples are: Developing a research plan; grant writing; choosing the right publication for your work; and combining open access and your research.

Statewide Libraries Day will be on May 20, 2016 at the Campus Center on the IUPUI Campus in Indianapolis, IN.
