1. **Data analysis report of SAT/ACT vs. GPA graduation rates and Discuss admissions policy: goal preparation for test optional change after reviewing data on graduation rates (SAT/ACT vs. GPA).** M. Parker gave stats about standardized tests, high schools GPA and student success correlations. From data given, high school GPA and students success have the strongest correlation. IU-care is still investigating. IU UFC to vote in Nov'19 on their recommendation. Vote expected to come to IUE campus after that. Discussion continues as investing is ongoing. AAA committee decided to await IU system process and recommendation before working on policy,
2. **Discuss draft version 6.0 – “Application for Reinstatement”:** goal is final approval of form to send to Senate for vote. (Blankenship). Discussed changes made to the application for reinstatement. Included Likert scale with behavioral statements. (M. Blankenship will add *have not used “any”* to Campus resources used. Update *“effective transition”* and “possess” to “have.” Agree as a committee to simplify language in the application ie Likert section. (Update from Agenda Committee: This item will go to Faculty Senate as an information item because it does not change policy.)
3. **Discuss incomplete policy: review campus policies from IU system and compare to ours. Brainstorming for possible changes to ours.** Discussion & decision to conform the IUE policy and be parallel with other campuses wording; M. Blankenship will get removal form and committee will examine how it is being implemented on other campuses.
4. **Discuss changing dates for readmission appeals.** Table shows an increase in the number of appeal dates. 2018-2019 held 3 post fall dates. Re-thinking current appeals day schedule. Considering mid-semester appeals dates, is this an efficient choice for committee work, to take appeals mid-semester. M.Blakenship will send out email for fall-early spring appeal date options.
5. **Discuss appeals success data collection.** (Hall and Bose) Deferred to next meeting.
