Record set for credit hours taken (73,598).

Nearly \$37 million in financial aid awarded to students.

The retention rate for students from first to second year increases from 60.2% to 65.6%.

\$27 million renovation of the Education and Arts Building is included in the 2007-09 biennium state budget passed by the Indiana General Assembly.

IU South Bend's impact on the local economy is estimated at \$66.2 million.

The first year of student housing achieves 81% occupancy rate.

The Titan's women's basketball team receives an NAIA Team Scholar Award with a 3.42 cumulative grade point average.

The School of Business and Economics is included for the third consecutive year in the list of Best Business Schools by the Princeton Review.

The Euclid Quartet receives a National Endowment for the Arts American Chamber Music grant. The award is one of only 33 nationwide and the only one awarded in Indiana.

Faculty and staff contribute \$42,794 to the campus campaign – a 30% increase over the previous year.
