**1. Chancellor’s Update**

 <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Fall 2021 Restart (for now!)</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">June 8, 2021</p> <p style="text-align: center;">         INDIANA UNIVERSITY        NORTHWEST     </p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Vaccine mandate</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For folks arriving at the very beginning of the semester, first vaccination due by July 1, 2021. (This allows time for second vaccination + 2 weeks); Fac/Staff by June 15 (to allow for August 2<sup>nd</sup> return)</li> <li>• We must attest that we are vaccinated after each vaccination (or after the first and only J&amp;J).</li> <li>• If students, faculty and staff provide proof of their vaccination by July 1, 2021, eligible for prizes:           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Students: grand prize 1 -year full tuition, then smaller prizes (parking permit, bookstore gift card)</li> <li>◦ Fac/Staff: grand prize: 2 season tickets to COLTs games, or to the Indiana Repertoire Theater, then Apple watch, Air Pods, Pro, JBL Speaker, Yeti cooler</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>If there is no attestation provided, nor an exception granted:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students disconnected from all IU systems, registration cancelled, Crimson Card terminated.</li> <li>• Fac/Staff will no longer be employed.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Exceptions – only considered by the Medical Response Team</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Religious – in accordance with Indiana state law</li> <li>• Medical – only with documentation from providers           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Very few: allergic reactions, use of the pharma Rituximab</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Medical deferrals -           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ Pregnant/breastfeeding</li> <li>◦ Recent transplant (up to 6 months)</li> </ul> </li> <li>• If a student is enrolled in a 100% On-line program</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Exempted people:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must wear masks at all times when indoors; when outside when physical distancing is not possible.</li> <li>• Must appear at Mitigation testing 2x per week.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Masks worn by All:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In events when participants come from outside the IU community.</li> <li>• In events with more than 250 people.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Surveillance testing – for all!</b></p> <p>Vaccinated and Exempted (this testing is called Mitigation testing)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>More for Restart!</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Restrictions of distancing and masking lifted</li> <li>• Physical Distancing/Space Capacity return to Pre-Pandemic status</li> <li>• Events greater than 250 people must be approved by the Events Review Committee</li> <li>• Consider, to the extent possible, having events outside</li> <li>• External folks at any event? – ALL wear masks</li> <li>• Flu vaccine will be mandated</li> <li>• GYM? – Pre-pandemic occupancy</li> </ul>

### 3. Boiler installation in Hawthorne Hall

- Crane on campus for 8-hour installation, building will be shut-down.
- June 18<sup>th</sup> will be boiler installation date.

  - Headcount -4.9%
  - Newly admitted students down -27%
