"Affectionately Yours: The Andrew Wylie Family Letters, 1828 to 1859" is a 276-page collection of wonderfully readable family correspondence offering us a very

touching and personal window onto life in Bloomington a century and a half ago. The letters were transcribed and compiled with support from an Indiana Heritage Research Grant and are available in spiral-bound book form from Wylie House Museum for \$17.85. You can access circstat to determine total charges, browses, and renewal circulation activity for the FY 94-95 just ended.

Catstat will give you totals for titles or volumes/items held, and will also allow you to get counts of title/volumes added to the catalog over the past FY.
