The regular biweekly meeting of the Bloomington Faculty Council, held in Presidents' Hall on Tuesday, February 5, convened at 2:30 PM with Provost Lauren Robel presiding and Padraic Kenney acting as Secretary.

1. Minutes of the meeting of January 15, 2019 were approved.
2. Vice Provost Eliza Pavalko read a memorial resolution for William Haeberle.
3. Vice Provost Eliza Pavalko read a memorial resolution for Anabel Powell Newman.
4. Diane Henshel, Chair of the Nominations Committee, presented a second reading of a proposal, Circular B21-2019, for allocating seats for non-tenure-track faculty in accordance with the amended constitution. The proposal passed by a show of hands.
5. Simon Brassell, Co-Chair of the Educational Policies Committee, reported on committee recommendations concerning the Diversity in the United States requirement of the General Education program. He also reported that the Committee will recommend to the Executive Committee that it convene a task force to review the General Education program.
6. Beth Gazley, Chair of the Faculty Board of Review, delivered a report on the actions of that body in 2017-18.
7. Jessica Lester, Chair of the Faculty Mediation Committee, delivered a report on the actions of that body in 2017-18.
8. Selene Carter, Co-Chair of the Diversity and Affirmative Action Committee, presented a for discussion a resolution calling for bystander training for faculty, students, and staff, in response to recent incidents of harrassment. Members proposed several friendly amendments, and the proposal passed by a show of hands.
