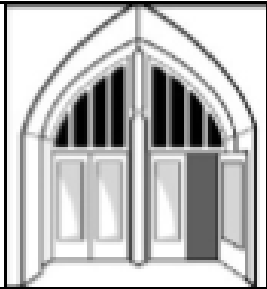

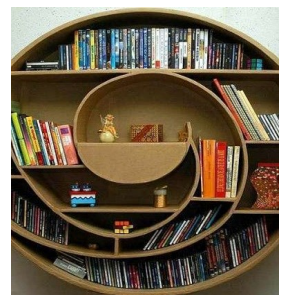


BOOK CIRCULATING

Are you an avid reader? Then consider joining the Book Circulating Group!

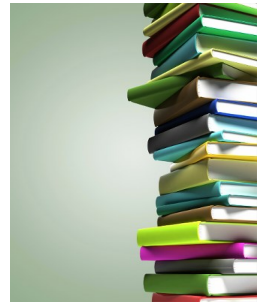

Thursday, July 21- Indiana Historical Society Tour and Jazz on the Canal-Indianapolis

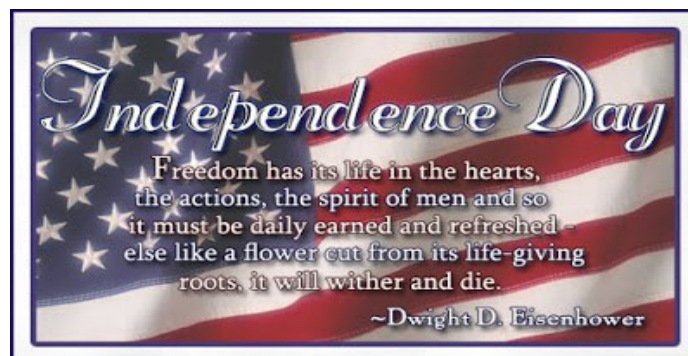
Departs 2:30 PM

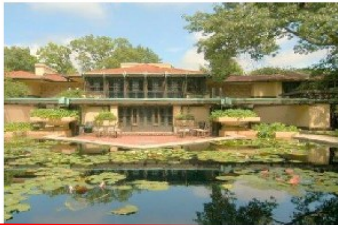

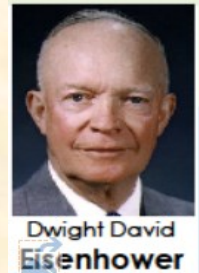
