III. Information Items

A. Proposed LEAP document

Laverne explained that LEAP Essential Learning Outcomes are being proposed for adoption by all of Indiana University's campuses. The framework is designed to satisfy the General Assembly's efforts to improve general education courses. If changes are not made by the universities, the assembly intends to mandate ten courses to improve general education programs. IUPUI, IU Northwest, and possibly Fort Wayne campuses have endorsed the LEAP proposal. Laverne stressed the importance that all IUE schools review the LEAP Essential Learning Outcomes and send feedback to the Curriculum Committee to be sent on to Faculty Senate.
