The MDPI project posed a tremendous technical challenge: digitize and process around 280,000 audio and video assets by the University's bicentennial. The first objects began processing in June 2015 and by the summer of 2016, the major problems had been worked out and the processing was proceeding smoothly. Then the discussions of film processing began.

In theory, processing film is the same as audio and video. On paper, it seems easier: even though the time allotted is less than A/V, there are only 25,000 reels to process. Upcoming Application Deadline for the InULA Grants Fund

Need monetary support for research or research-related activities? The InULA Grants Fund is intended to encourage and support research by providing funding for projects of any size or scope. Grant applications are now being accepted through April 16, 2018. Guidelines and application information can be found at: http://www.indiana.edu/~inula/wp_2012/inula-research-incentive-fund-guidelines/. You must be a current member of InULA to be eligible. The InULA Grants and Scholarship Committee will review grant applications using a rubric. In the case of equally meritorious proposals, those of non-tenured librarians may be given priority because it is often difficult for beginning researchers to obtain research grants. Recommendations will then be made to the InULA Executive Board for approval and funding. Notice of awards is provided to applicants as soon as possible. Can't get an application in by April 16? The next fund deadline is October 15, 2018. Please contact the committee chair for more information or with questions.
