The InULA membership also voted to accept both proposed amendments to the Constitution and Bylaws:

- Remove references to "mail" when referring to ballots

## 2017 Indiana University Libraries Information Literacy Colloquium

Thursday, August 3, 2017

8:30am – 4:00pm

Indiana University Southeast, New Albany, Indiana.

We are pleased to announce that registration for the 2017 Indiana University Libraries Information Literacy Colloquium is now open!

The Colloquium seeks to explore which pedagogical strategies and theoretical perspectives librarians might employ to engage students in complex conversations about the nature of credibility, truth, and authority. Attendees of this colloquium will have the opportunity to participate in 90 minute workshops designed to engage participants in raising questions, proposing solutions, and generating ideas around information literacy instruction in the current sociopolitical climate.

The online registration is available at <http://go.iu.edu/1DZr>. Registration is limited to 100 participants and will end on Friday, July 28. The \$60 registration fee will include breakfast, lunch, and snack breaks.

Participants may stay at a nearby hotel or on campus. On-campus housing registration, accessible via the main registration form, closes on July 13, and on-campus housing registration fees are non-refundable after this date. Colloquium cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to [maccardi@ius.edu](mailto:maccardi@ius.edu), and are subject to a \$20 cancellation fee due to required processing fees. Cancellations received after July 28 are non-refundable.

The 2017 Indiana University Libraries Information Literacy Colloquium is excited to announce that we are offering free registration scholarships for current library science students enrolled in graduate programs or who are graduating this summer. There are four (4) free registrations available. To apply for a free registration, please send a brief essay of no more than 500 words to [lowekat@iu.edu](mailto:lowekat@iu.edu) describing how attending the Colloquium will help you further your career goals and professional development. Please also attach documentation that you are currently enrolled or are about to graduate from library school (something like a screen shot of your current registered courses will suffice). Application deadline is July 18, 2017 by 5:00 pm Eastern Time. Notifications will be sent out by July 25.
