Update on Academic Master Plan

Academic Master Plan document will include:

- Program Review Process, New Programs, and Academic Portfolio recommendations to Sustain, Grow, Suspend/Sunset.
- Will not include Programs for Further Exploration & Discussion.
- AMP document will be edited to reflect these changes and published; review as needed/desired.
- AMP will be used as a plan for sustaining, growing and suspending/sunseting programs included in this document.

Goal: Have an Academic Master Plan completed in March 2024.

Update on Academic Master Plan

Programs for Further Exploration & Discussion will be included in a new multi-year Low-Enrolled Program Management Plan (LMP)

- This year, focus on a small number of programs for “direction” decisions (e.g., develop collaborative degree, join online degree, develop as concentrations within larger degree, sunset, etc.)
 - These programs would be given AY 2024-25 to create a plan.
 - List to be generated by end of March 2024, pending Regional Chancellors input for degrees shared by 2 or more campuses or identified by VPRCOE.
- During Fall 2024, refresh and review program enrollments to identify the next set of programs to address. Repeat in Fall 2025.
- In August and September 2024, workshops and other resources made available to these and other programs wishing to develop plans to improve enrollments.
- A draft LMP document outlining the process will be completed by May 2024. After August 2026, use regular program review and program viability reviews to monitor.
