You must be a current member of InULA to be eligible. The InULA Grants and Scholarship Committee will review grant applications using a rubric. In the case of equally meritorious proposals, those of non-tenured librarians may be given priority because it is often difficult for beginning researchers to obtain research grants. Recommendations will then be made to the InULA Executive Board for approval and funding. Notice of awards is provided to applicants as soon as possible. Can't get an application in by January 15? Other fund deadlines are April 15, 2018 and October 15, 2018.

### Welcome Mario Ramirez, CLIR Postdoctoral Fellow for Data Curation in Latin American and Caribbean Studies

The Indiana University Libraries were awarded a Council on Library and Information Resources Postdoctoral Fellowship in Data Curation for Latin American and Caribbean Studies. This two-year position is based in the IU Libraries with an affiliation at the Center for Latin American and Caribbean Studies.

I am pleased to announce that Mario H. Ramirez has accepted the Postdoc position. Mario comes to us with nearly 20 years of collective library and archival experience from his time at the New York Public Library, the Center for Puerto Rican Studies at CUNY, and the Bancroft Library. Mario has MS in Library and Information Science, and recently completed his PhD at UCLA in Information Studies. His research focused on the documentation of human rights violations in El Salvador and issues pertaining to human rights more generally in Latin America.

Mario will initially focus on the migration and revitalization of the Archivo Mesoamericano (<http://archivomesoamericano.org/>), a digital archive of annotated historical and ethnographic video materials created in collaboration with the Center for Research and Advanced Studies in Social Anthropology in Mexico, the Institute of History of Nicaragua and Central America in Nicaragua, and the Museum of the Word and the Image in El Salvador. In addition to his work on the Archivo, Mario will work closely with librarians, technologists, faculty, and graduate students to further knowledge in data curation across this broader geographic, multidisciplinary space with a special focus on audio/video content.

Mario will be part of Digital Collections Services, and will have a close working relationship with Luis Gonzalez, Librarian for Latin American Studies. Mario's first day is January 16, 2018. Please join me in welcoming Mario!
