A 32-Hour Workshop for Community Members and other Hoosiers

Interested in learning about general communication skills, constructive conflict resolution, and basic mediation processes? CJAM is seeking a few good neighbors interested in constructive conflict resolution, restorative justice, and the mediation process to attend 32-Hour Basic Mediation Training. "Basic Mediation Training" is a great tool to add to the lifelong toolbox of community members interested in more productively communicating with other people and resolving conflict in constructive ways. Participants who complete CJAM's "Basic Mediation Training" are eligible to participate in CJAM's Community Mediator Apprenticeship Program. Tuition for the training is \$200, although a sliding scale and scholarships are available. Registration forms are available by emailing training@ciamcenter.org. CJAM is a not-for-profit community leader in collaborative decision-making and conflict resolution, and CJAM's experienced mediators have facilitated the resolution of a wide variety of community conflicts such as neighbor-to-neighbor and landlord-tenant disputes, Victim-Offender Reconciliation, and school and workplace disagreements among many others.
