## HISTORICAL NOTES

Built in 1908 by Albert R. Beardsley, one of the early organizers of Miles Laboratories, Inc., *RUTHMERE* was named after Albert and Elizabeth's only child, Ruth, who died in infancy. English-born architect E. Hill Turnock designed this residence in the 'French Style,' using American building materials wherever possible. The impressive result combines the elaborate formality of the Beaux Arts style with the functional elements of the Midwestern Prairie school of architecture.

In 1924 *RUTHMERE* was acquired by A. R.'s nephew, Arthur, who lived here until his death in 1944 when the house was sold out of the family. It was bought by the Andrew Hubble Beardsley Foundation in 1969 and opened to the public as a House Museum, September 8, 1973 by Indiana Governor Otis R. Bowen.
