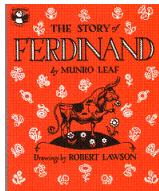

Students in Dr. Tulley’s E341 Methods of Teaching Reading in the Elementary School II class participated in a service learning/volunteer activity with the Howard County Habitat for Humanity organization on Saturday, September 8th. The Habitat building site is located within the city of Kokomo, and students each contributed over five hours of labor to the build, beginning at 8:00 a.m., and concluding when the rains came at approximately 1:30 p.m. The involvement of these TEP students marked the first time an organized group from IU Kokomo has participated in a local Habitat build. Next Saturday, September 15, students enrolled in another of Dr. Tulley’s courses will participate in a habitat build, and plans are already in place for students enrolled in his Spring 2008 courses to participate, as well, with the local Habitat chapter.
