EXPLANATION OF ENROLLMENT DATA

1. Registration cut-off dates for Student Census differed due to the variance in session dates. The session and cut-off dates are shown below:

2. Starting with the Summer of 2012 summer reporting was changed from session based reporting to term based reporting. Summer is treated as a regular term much like fall and spring. Census was/will be taken on August 1st and will include all enrolled students and/or students who have completed courses in the summer term. If August 1st falls on a Sunday then census will be taken the following Monday.

3. Credit hour figures are net figures that reflect courses dropped and added up to the dates cited above; students who withdrew from all courses are not included in the headcount and credit hours count.

4. New Reporting classes to comply with IPEDS reporting.

a. Doctoral – Research

These are students who were previously classified as Doctoral and included in the Graduate level.

b. Doctoral – Practice

These are students who were previously classified as Professional but may also include programs defined by the institution as degrees leading to “practice” professions, i.e. Audiology, Nursing, etc.

5. Undergraduate and Doctoral-Practice:

a. Part-time: student enrolled for less than 12 credit hours.

b. Full-time: students enrolled for 12 credit hours or more.

c. Full-time-equivalent: the sum of all undergraduate and professional student credit hours divided by 15.

6. Graduate:

a. Part-time: students enrolled for less than 9 credit hours.

b. Full-time: students for 9 credit hours or more.

c. Full-time-equivalent: the sum of all graduate student credit hours divided by 12.

7. Special students (students who are not enrolled in regular undergraduate or graduate degree programs):

a. Special Undergraduate:

Full-time-equivalent: the sum of all special undergraduate student credit hours divided by 15.

b. Special Graduate:

Full-time-equivalent: the sum of all special graduate student credit hours divided by 12.
