### **Finding aids now available online for:**

Dept. of Student Guidance Director's records, Collection 27: A student guidance program was established at Indiana University in the fall of 1939 to help incoming students adjust to college life. Herman T. Briscoe served as the director of the department during its short existence, as in 1942 the program and its responsibilities were replaced by the Junior Division (now known as the University Division). Collection consists of correspondence, budget files, reports, and the director's committee files. Prominent in the collection are lists of faculty advisors and correspondence regarding the advisory services. (1 cubic foot)

**Residence Halls Association records, Collection C229:** In 1960, due to the development of co-educational living centers, the then-existing Men's and Women's Residence Halls Associations were combined into one co-educational organization, the Residence Halls Association. Records in this collection include but are not limited to correspondence, minutes, memos, publications, election and committee files, and reports from the time of its establishment in 1960 to 2002. The bulk of the collection dates between 1980 and 1996. (4.8 cubic feet)

**University Council records, Collection C233:** The University Council was created by a vote of the general faculty on 10 January 1929. The purpose of this group was to consider any question of academic policy affecting the University as a whole. This collection spans 1929-1940 and is organized into three series: Minutes, Reports and recommendations, and Memos. (.3 cubic feet)

Accession 2004/021: Ira Wilmer "Will" Counts papers; former Professor Emeritus of Journalism; primarily consisting of photographs, negatives, slides, and exhibit equipment. (approx. 40 cubic feet)

Accession 2004/022: IU Athletics films. (10 cubic feet)

Accession 2004/024: Myron Greene (DDS 1940) papers, 1940-1945; primarily consists of Greene's correspondence with his wife during WWII.(1 cubic foot)

Accession 2004/027: IU Auditorium records, 1941-1993; consists of show files and general records. (30 cubic feet)

Accession 2004/028: James Ambros King papers, 1950-2004; former Professor of Music; primarily consists of notebooks, correspondence, sheet music, programs, photographs, and clippings. (14 cubic feet)
