This report illustrates financial aid awarded to students enrolled at time of census in any one of the semesters that comprise the fiscal year of 2004-05. With this report we introduce several changes in format and with the definition of the aid data.

The new information systems implemented in the student financials area have necessitated a thorough review and refinement of the various sources and types of aid. As such, the aid figures for this report were different enough in some cases to preclude the use of percent change from the previous year. Rather, measures are added to reflect the percent of total aid, and percent of total aid within the various demographic or student characteristics.

Data are provided - on the next page for the university and on the bottom half of the campus pages - that provide the percent of students that have received aid by type and total aid. Cells with 10 or less are perturbed.

As always, we appreciate your comments and ideas on improving this report.

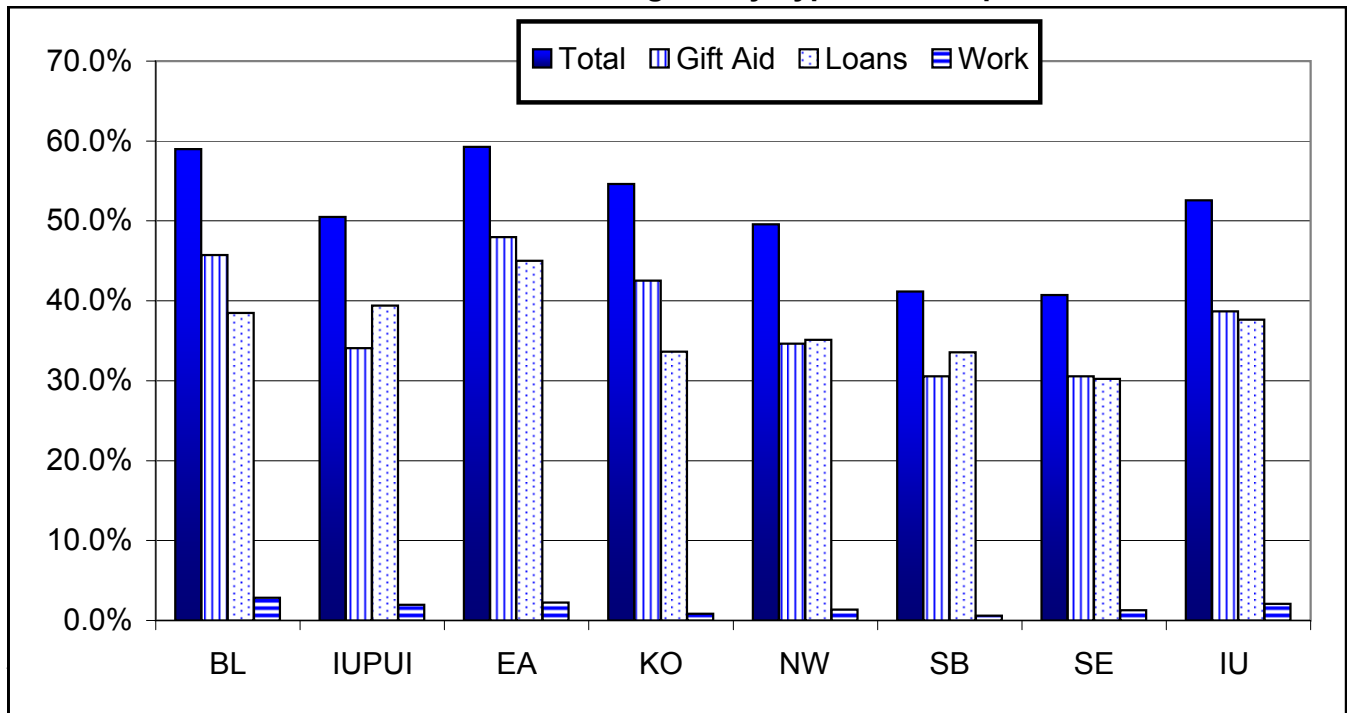
