In the 2006–2007 academic year the Indiana University Kokomo Faculty Senate Admissions Committee conducted the following business:

- In September, 2006 the Admissions Committee worked with the Registrar, Melanie Hough, to clarify the policy for notifying students who, because their semester GPAs fell below 2.0, are technically on academic probation. A modification in the language describing the Academic Probation and Dismissal Policy in the *Bulletin* was approved by the Faculty Senate.
- In December, 2006 we evaluated petitions submitted by three doubly-dismissed students requesting readmission for Spring, 2007. Not only were all three students punctual for their interviews, but each of them showed great promise for a successful return to college. The committee granted readmission to all three students. There were no applicants for readmission for Fall 2006.
