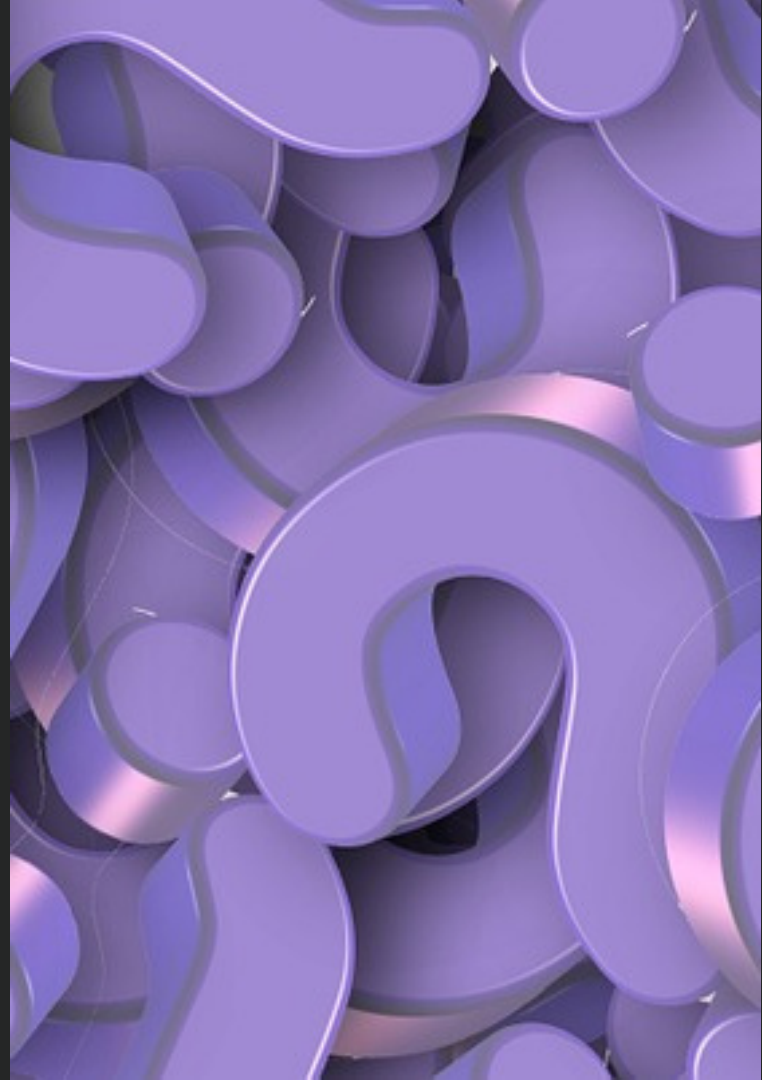




What is an Academic Master Plan?

“Strategic plan” for the academic program portfolio of the campus

Provides direction for decision making in support of the academic mission of the campus



Outcomes

1. Comprehensive review of academic program portfolio to explore programs we might *develop, grow, sustain, revitalize, or sunset*
2. Ensure our program review process is sustaining vibrant programs focused on our institutional mission and strategic priorities



Revised Timeline – this semester

- April 10 – AMP Draft to school/college reps for input
- April 24 – input received
- May 8 – Updates made & draft out to campus for input
- May 22 – Campus input received
- June – Academic Master Plan finalized



Timeline – next semester

- Early in fall 2023, departments will finalize with their Dean a planned timeline for programs they will be developing, revitalizing, growing, or sunseting



Sequencing priorities

- New program development & sunseting programs
 - Prioritized due to long timeline for planning & approvals
- Recommendations requiring budgetary commitments
 - Prioritized based on funding needs & availability



Reminders

- Governance and approval processes for curricular changes, creation, and sunseting must be followed before implementation.
- The overall goal is to make progress, where possible, during the 2024-25 academic year and considerable progress by Fall 2025.
