88.1 WVPE, celebrating 25 years as your voice for public radio, is proud to present bluesman, Eddy Clearwater, as part of the WVPE Performance Series.

Blues rocker, Eddy Clearwater is most widely recognized for his powerful left handed guitar playing, outrageous stage costumes and energetic music!

In 1953, Clearwater began playing as 'Guitar Eddy' in the South and West sides of Chicago. Just a few years later, he earned the reputation of being a great blues showman by combining left handed/ upside down guitar playing and an outlandish stage performance. Until the late 1970's, Eddy remained one of Chicago's 'hidden treasures', playing in clubs and refining his style.

Throughout the 70's, The Chief of the Blues toured Europe twice, appeared on BBC television, and recorded in France, all while receiving awards for his recordings. Today, Clearwater continues to generate a buzz in the music industry and is recognized for his style and performance worldwide.
