What is going on with e-delivery? If you signed up for e-delivery of *NewsWatch* yet you continue to receive a copy through the mail, you may be wondering what is going on. This dual delivery is the result of IURA having to meet a minimum mail requirement in order to qualify to use the Postal Permit. To reach that minimum we need to include in our mailing those who have signed up for e-delivery. However, from August through November we meet those minimum requirements without including those who want e-delivery. Thus in the fall those who have signed up for e-delivery will receive ONLY an electronic version of *NewsWatch*. Even with this strange arrangement, e-delivery still helps both the environment and IURA, just not as much as we originally thought.
