2018 Jenkins Award Announcement

The Jenkins Award Committee is pleased to announce that Dina Kellams, Director of the Indiana University Archives, has been awarded the 2018 William Evans Jenkins Librarian Award.

The Jenkins Award is presented in recognition of truly outstanding contributions to the Indiana University Libraries or to the library profession. Dina has excelled as an archivist, supervisor and director, and in the words of one of the many who supported her nomination “embodies all the skills and values of a talented academic librarian and colleague.”

Dina is an expert archivist, and her colleagues describe her leadership as “pleasantly contagious” and point to it as the “reason morale is so high in the IU Archives.” She has actively published and presented at many professional conferences. She recently coauthored with Vice President Emeritus J. Terry Clapacs and her colleague Carrie Schwier Indiana University Bloomington: America’s Legacy Campus (2017. IU Press).

Her other notable achievements include the Primary Immersion Workshop she launched in collaboration with her colleagues and the rediscovery of Carrie Parker Taylor, the first African American woman to enroll at IU, in 1898. J. Terry Clapacs starts his support letter by affirming that “Dina excels in every aspect of her role at Indiana University.”

Dr. James Capshew, University Historian, praises Dina as “a perfect blend of an academic librarian that can deal with the minutia of archival services and possesses the ability to focus on the big picture, whether it is a historical question or an issue of archival planning and management.” He goes on to say that Dina is “a trusted source of wise counsel due to her deep experience, technical expertise, and compassionate nature.”

IUCAT My Account Access Ends for PFW Patrons

As part of the transition of the IPFW campus from the shared governance of IU and Purdue to solely Purdue, the IPFW Helmke Library will be migrating their holdings out of IUCAT and into an independent online library catalog. The final data transfer to the new PFW catalog will occur on May 25, 2018.

In preparation for this final data transfer, effective May 24 at 10:00pm EDT, PFW patrons will no longer have access to IUCAT My Account services, including online renewal, account review, etc.

A banner communicating this information will be added to the IUCAT Fort Wayne view and to relevant articles about IUCAT in the UITS Knowledge Base.

Last Sunday, May 6, we released a long-desired improvement for IUCAT: e-book is now available as a format. We have heard from many of you, and from many of our IUB patrons, that our previous format designation for e-books, which required the display of both the Book and Online Resource format, was confusing. We are glad to be able to put that confusion behind us!

As you can see in the embedded image below, we now instead have an 'e-book' format which will be displayed in bib records and search results, and which can be used to filter results.
