##### **IU Finding Aids is now Archives Online at Indiana University!**

We changed the name to better reflect the variety of collections to be found in the site, and to make the site more welcoming to non-archival specialists. Archives Online at IU contains guides for archival collections, or finding aids, from units across IU Bloomington and is open to contributions from other IU campuses. In addition to the University Archives and the Lilly Library, Archives Online at IU serves finding aids for the Archives of African American Music

and Culture, Center for the Study of History and Memory, the Folklore Collection, the Liberian Collections, and the Political Papers. Our newest units include the Black Film Center/Archive, the Wylie House Museum, and the African Studies Collection.

Many of the finding aids included in Archives Online at IU link to digitized objects, notably the President Herman B. Wells speeches (<http://purl.dlib.indiana.edu/iudl/findingaids/archives/InU-Ar-VAA2642>), from the IU Archives, Jane Johnson's Manuscript Nursery Library (<http://purl.dlib.indiana.edu/iudl/findingaids/lilly/InU-Li-VAA1275>), from the Lilly Library, and the Andrew Wylie, Jr. family collection (<http://purl.dlib.indiana.edu/iudl/findingaids/wyliehouse/VAC0754>), from the Wylie House Museum.
