***Technical Services Move Update, IU Bloomington**

The final physical merger of the Technical Services Department at IU Bloomington will take place over this semester break. The new physical arrangements are aligned with the functional organization that went into effect on April 19. Electrical and telecommunications work on the third floor should be finished by the 27th of Dec. A professional moving company is coming in the weeks of Dec. 20 and 27 to do the physical move. All persons currently on the third floor will have their desks moved and the people currently working on the ground floor (in the former Serials area) will be moved up to the third floor. For these two weeks, all phone calls will be forwarded to 855-1666 (third floor) or 855-5672 (ground floor).
