2. Watch for an email confirming your chosen Zoom date. Two business days prior to your prep meeting, you will receive additional emails with your Zoom link and joining instructions.
3. Create your IU computing account as soon as you are able by clicking [HERE](#). (If you have already created an IU account from taking an ACP/Dual credit course through any IU campus, great. We can help you access your existing account during your first meeting.)
4. Complete your required registration prep survey by clicking [HERE](#). It takes about 15 minutes and helps make sure your academic advisor has all the info they need to put together the right fall course schedule for you!

IU Kokomo New Student Orientation

New Student Orientation overview:

Step 1: Prep meeting and IU Account setup

Step 2: Course registration at an on-campus Enrollment Event (half-day, guests welcome)

Step 3: Individual Academic Advising meeting (in person or via Zoom)

Small-Group Zoom Meeting: Preparation Session

An IU Kokomo Cougar Crew Member will guide you through some simple but critical preparatory steps in this 30-minute small-group session. You will confirm your IU computing account and your IU Gmail, and create an ALEKS math skills assessment account. You will be introduced to our New Student Orientation Canvas site and shown how to register for your choice of half-day Enrollment Events. Finally, you will be shown a few main tasks to complete on your own before your event date arrives.

Your Crew member will also make sure you get a chance to meet the other students in attendance. We expect you will find this meeting to be relaxed, reassuring, and informative.

Half-day on-campus event: Course enrollment

We are excited to welcome you on campus for your Enrollment Event! At this half-day event running from lunch through mid-afternoon, you will get to meet academic advisors and other students as you are guided through course registration.

The sooner you complete your required homework tasks, the sooner your academic advisor can prepare your individualized set of courses for your Enrollment Event. Your completed survey, submitted transcripts, and math assessment scores will help ensure that your recommended course schedule is accurate. At your Enrollment Event, you will learn how to use IU tools to register for the classes your advisor recommends. You will also set your post-registration appointment for your one-on-one academic advising meeting.

You are welcome to bring family or other guests to your Enrollment Event. While you are registering for classes, we'll have a special program just for them so they can support you well after classes start.

One-on-one meeting: Academic Advising

After you are registered for classes, we want to get to know you and your goals better, provide you great resources and ideas for a successful college journey, and answer any remaining questions. So this appointment will be with your academic advisor and can take up to an hour. You will be able to choose to meet via Zoom or in person, whatever your preference. If you need to adjust your schedule, your advisor will help you do that in this meeting.

We will provide you more information as Fall 2022 approaches about upcoming on-campus programs and opportunities so you can really feel comfortable and prepared before classes start in August. Once you have an IU Gmail account, these updates will be sent to that address – so keep an eye on that inbox!

We hope during your New Student Orientation experience you begin to feel like our campus is your future home. We already see you as part of our Cougar family and are eager to hear about your goals and questions.
