[Academic Search Premier](#)

Multi-disciplinary database that indexes and includes full-text to scholarly publications covering academic areas of study including social sciences, humanities, education, computer sciences, engineering, language and linguistics, arts & literature, medical sciences, and ethnic studies.

[CQ Researcher](#)

The *CQ Researcher* is the choice of researchers seeking original, comprehensive reporting and analysis on issues in the news. The single-themed *CQ Researcher* report offers in-depth, non-biased coverage of political and social issues, with regular reports on topics in health, international affairs, education, the environment, technology and the U.S. economy.

[Criminal Justice Abstracts](#)

Indexes criminal justice topics which include crime trends, crime prevention and deterrence, juvenile delinquency and juvenile justice, police, courts, punishment and sentencing, and victimology. Indexes reports from government and non-governmental agencies, books, dissertations, and unpublished papers.

[GPO Access Databases](#)

GPO Access is a service of the U.S. Government Printing Office that provides free electronic access to information products produced by the Federal Government. The information provided on this site is the official, published version and the information retrieved from *GPO Access* can be used without restriction, unless specifically noted. This free service is funded by the Federal Depository Library Program.

[Health Source: Consumer Edition](#)

Provides full-text consumer health periodicals for topics including nutrition, exercise, medical self-care, childcare, and drug and alcohol abuse. The database also includes *Clinical Reference Systems Reports*, *Lexi-PAL Drug Guide*, full-text pamphlets, and books published by the People's Medical Society.

[Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition](#)

Provides access to nearly 550 scholarly full-text journals, and 850 indexed journals. Covers nursing allied health and medical journals.

[NewsBank NewsFile Collection](#)

Contains full-text news articles covering social, economic, environmental, government, sports, the arts, people, health and science issues and events from more than 500 U.S. regional and national newspapers, wire services, and broadcasts.

[Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center](#)

A complete one-stop source for information on social issues, including articles, topic overviews, statistics, primary documents, links to Web sites, and full-text magazine and newspaper articles.

[PsycINFO](#)

This index from the American Psychological Association (APA) contains over two million citations and summaries of scholarly journal articles, book chapters, books, and dissertation, all in psychology and related disciplines, dating as far back as the 1800s. Full-text articles from journals published by the American Psychological Association and allied organizations are available. All journals are indexed in *PsycINFO* and linked to the full-text in the *PsycARTICLES* database.

Social Services Abstracts

Provides abstracts of journal articles and dissertations as well as citations to book reviews of current research focused on social work, human services, and related areas, including social welfare, social policy, and community development.

Sociological Abstracts

Indexes the international literature in sociology and related disciplines in the social and behavioral sciences. Provides abstracts of journal articles, books, book chapters, dissertations, and conference papers, as well as citations to book reviews.
