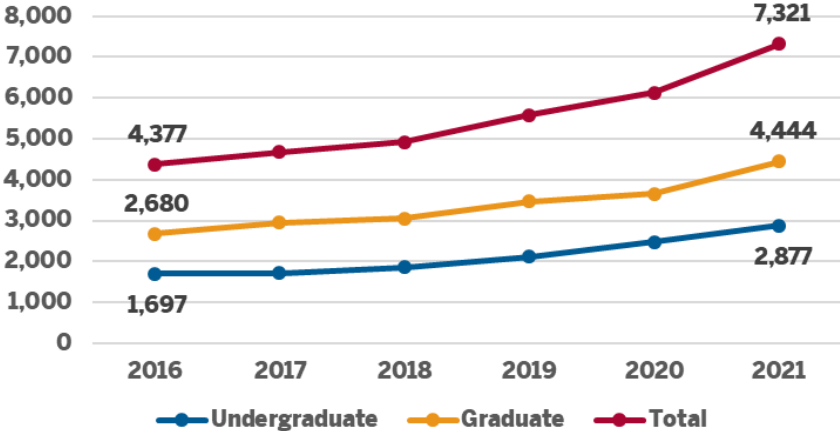

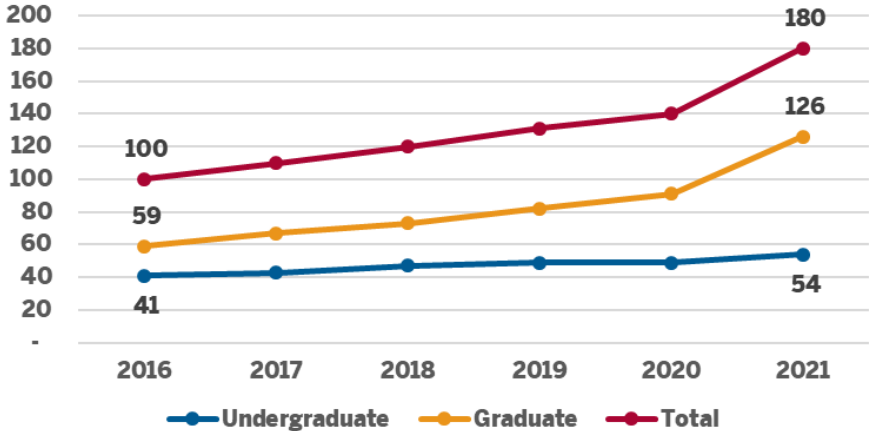

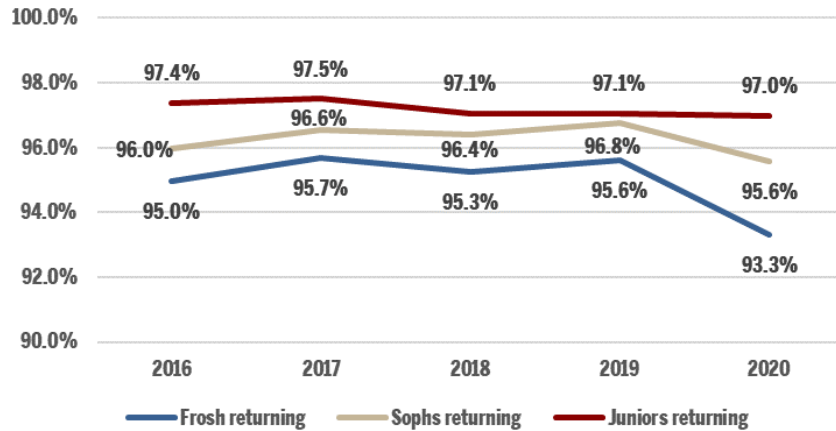

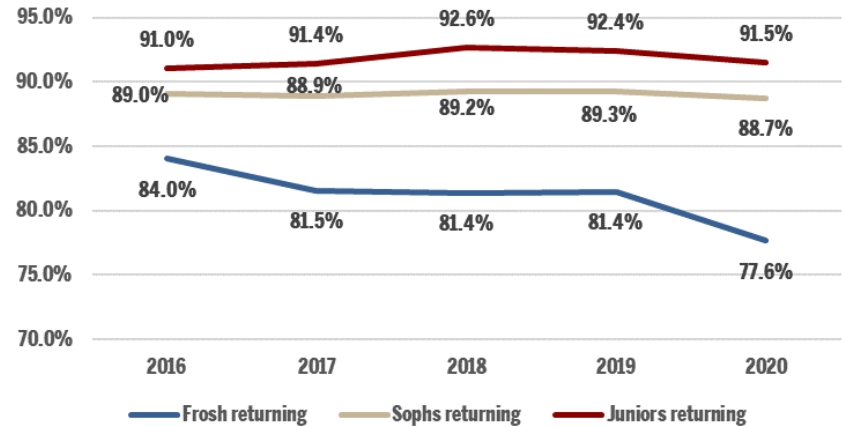

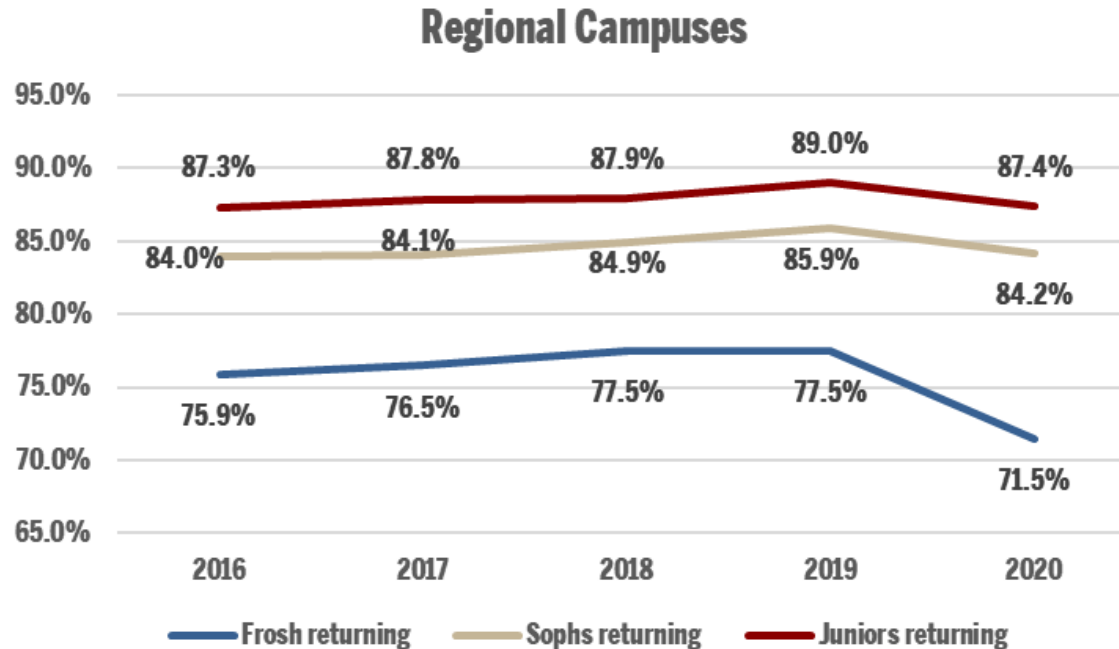

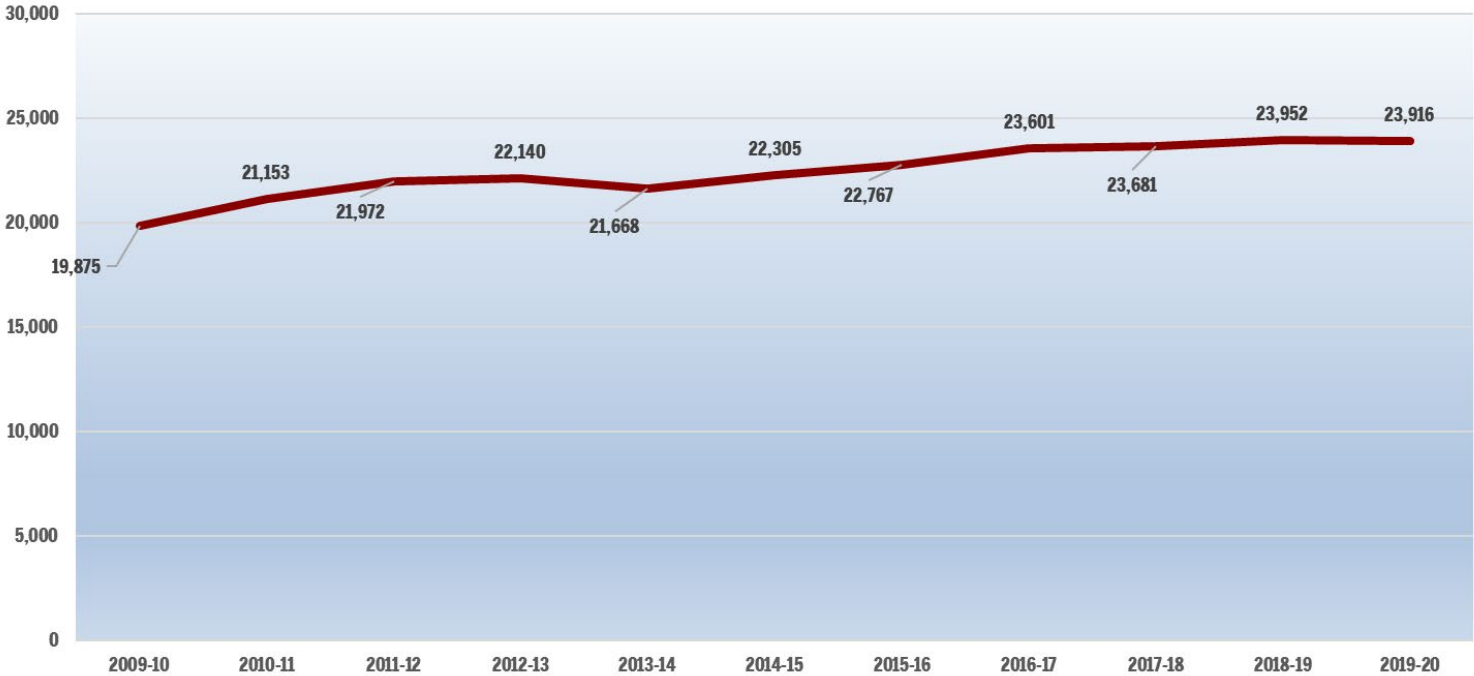

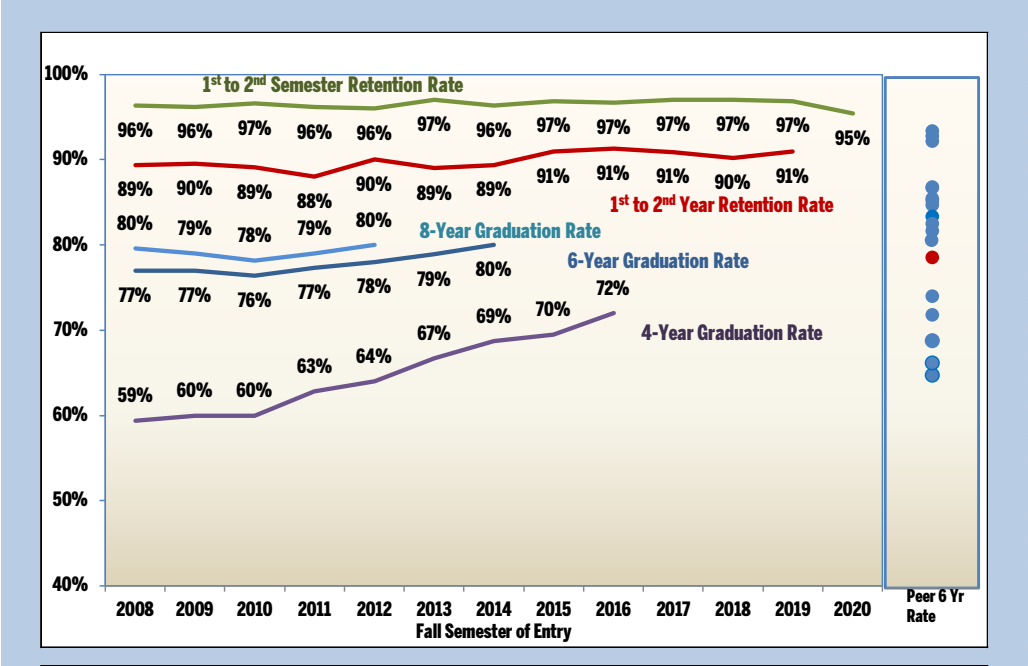

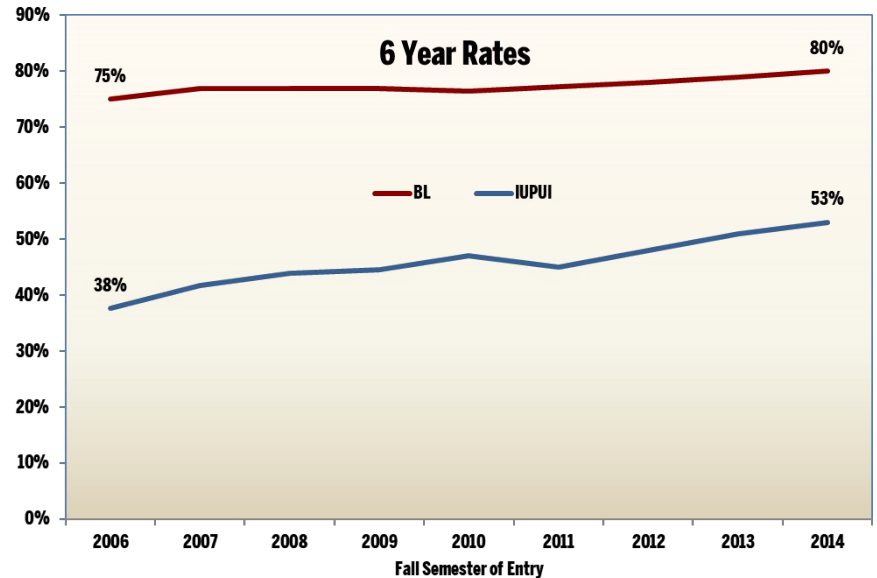

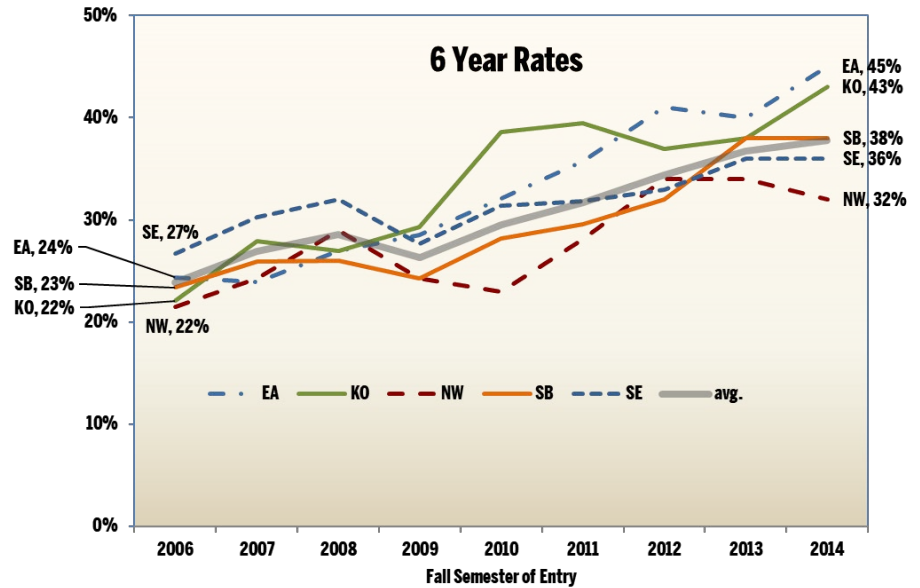
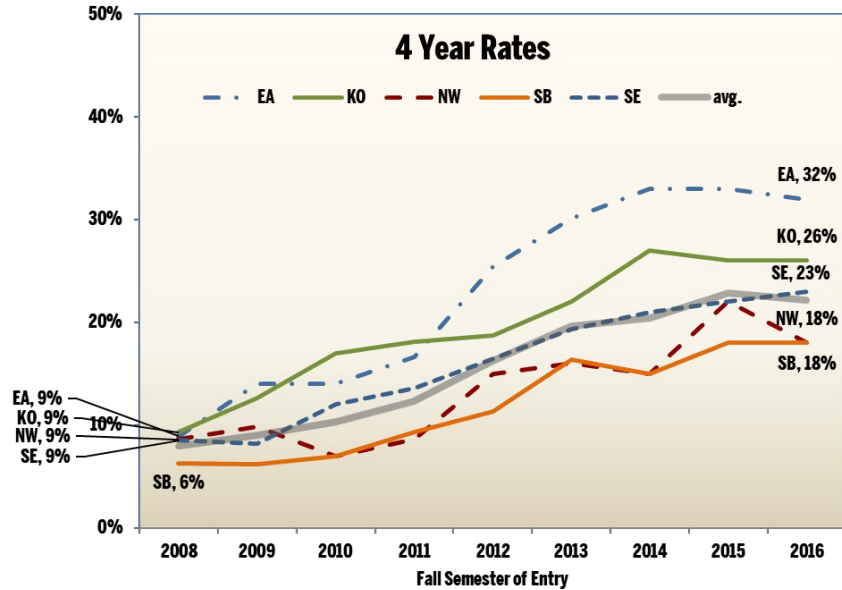
Retention & Graduation Rates – Example



Graduation Rates – Bloomington & IUPUI

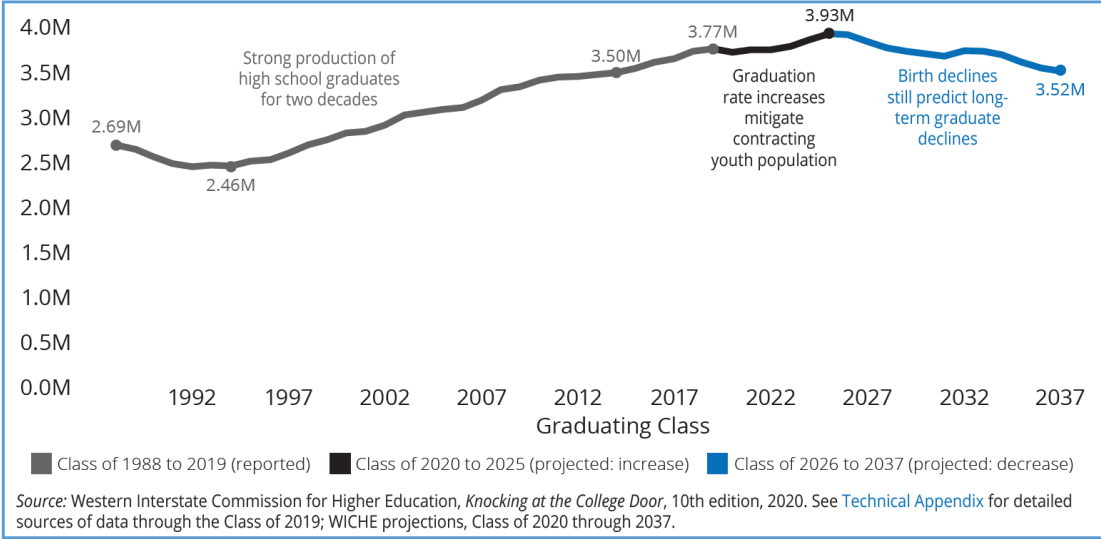


Graduation Rates – Regional Campuses

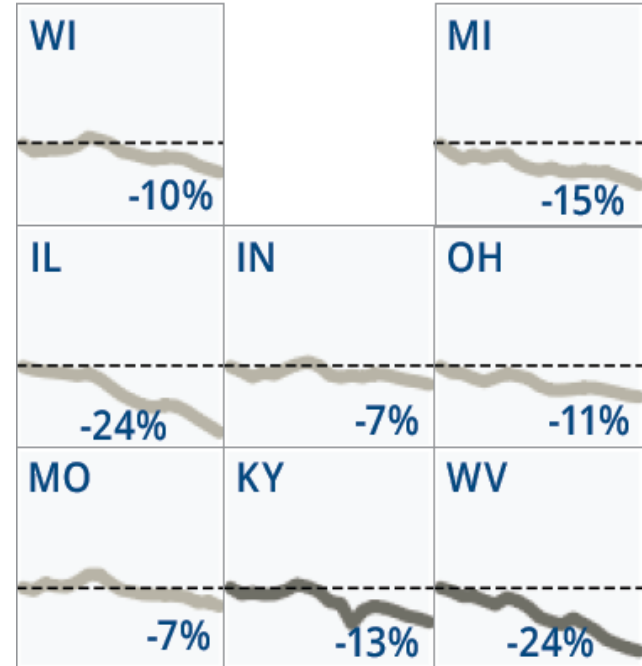
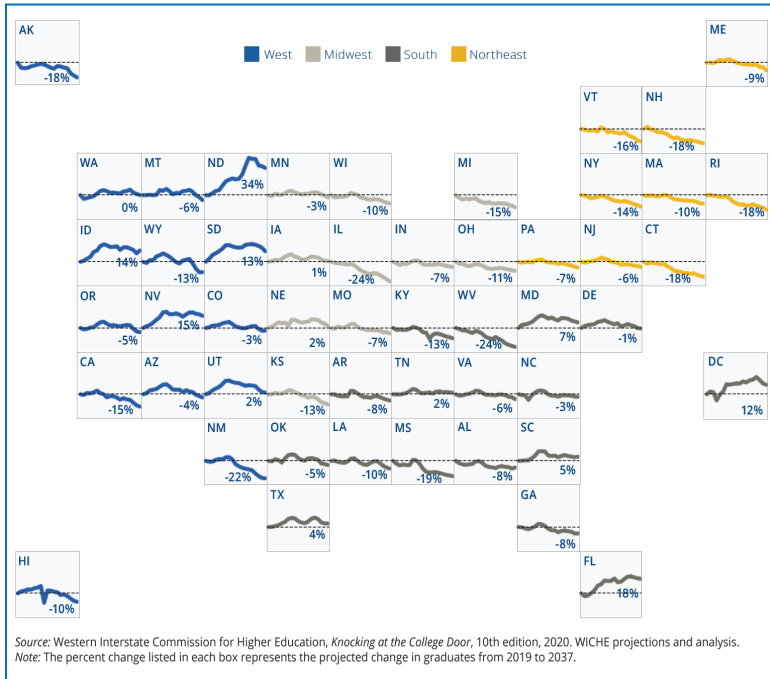

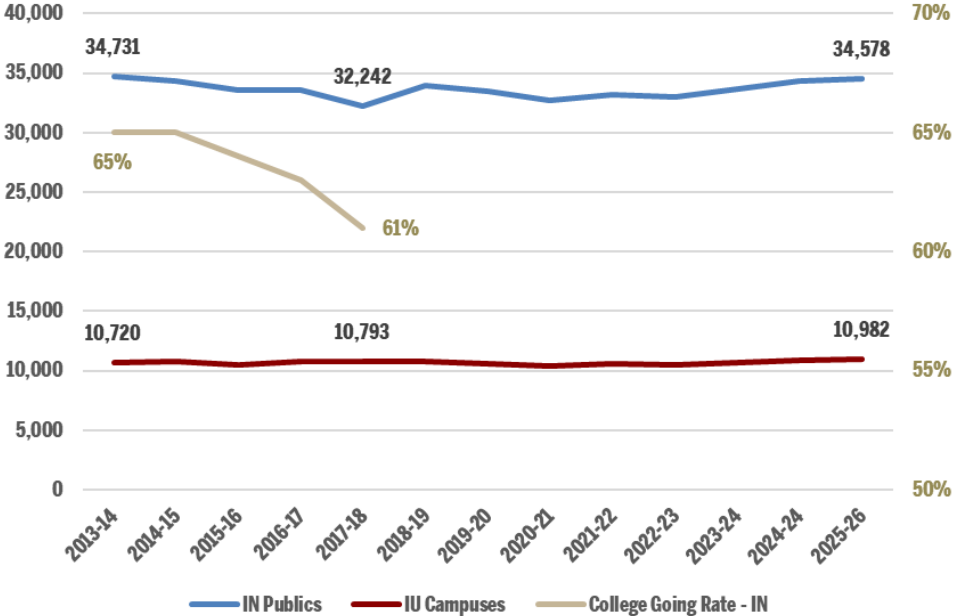
Figure 1. Slowing Growth in Number of U.S. High School Graduates, then Decline (U.S. Total High School Graduates)
