User Behavior and Website/Discovery Layer Design

Our presentation describes the implementation process of Primo at Franklin College to date. In the spring of 2011, the initial implementation phase consisted of interface design and functionality through informal usability studies. In addition, our presentation focuses on the continuous use of Primo in instructional sessions and the evaluation of the Primo as it is used by students.
