

## InULA Web site Ad Hoc Committee

In May 2011, The InULA Web site Ad Hoc Committee was charged with reviewing the current InULA web site and making recommendations for a upgrade and migration (see full charge below). The Committee conducted a survey of the membership to assess needs and investigated options for content management systems, culminating in two reports delivered to the Board (in August and September 2011). [reports also attached] These reports summarized the responses from members regarding critical functionality, recommended that InULA transition the web site to Wordpress, a content management system, and outlined a general timeline and overview of steps for the process.

Charge: The InULA Web site will undergo review and upgrades over the summer of 2011. An Ad Hoc Committee will be charged to decide how to move forward with the upgrade of the InULA Web site, work on the functional requirements, and decide whom to hire (e.g., SLIS student) to implement and program these functional requirements. The general review of the content of the site will be done by the Communications Committee. Every Web page will be scrutinized for functionality before it is migrated into a database-driven site.
