1. Commencement: Faculty members who will be taking part in the 1970 IUSB Commencement next Wednesday, June 3, may robe in Room N131, starting at 2:45 p. m.

By 3:25, all elements of the commencement group should be lined up in the long, north-south corridor on the second floor of Northside Hall. Faculty position in the procession will be behind the degree candidates and ahead of the platform party. Dean Risler will serve as faculty marshal.

The procession will move outside through the upper parking lot door, then right and down the stairway to the lower parking lot, then left to the grassy area overlooking the parking lot.

In case of rain, the procession will move through the audio-visual corridor, down the stairs, through the dressing-room corridor to the Green Room and onto the auditorium stage.

2. Baccalaureate: All faculty and staff members are invited to attend the Senior Class Baccalaureate service in the auditorium at 7:30 p. m. Sunday, May 31.

Dr. Roland W. Chamblee, South Bend physician, will deliver the baccalaureate address.
