Archives News

Ronald Richard Smith papers, 1973-1996, Collection C143: Ronald Richard Smith was a member of the Folklore faculty at Indiana University from 1978-1997. His research centered around traditional music, festivals, movement and dance, and religion within the African Diaspora, with a focus on Caribbean peoples. In addition to his teaching responsibilities at IU, Smith also served as associate dean of the Office of Research and University Graduate School from 1988-1996, headed the IU Ethnomusicology Program, and spent one year as director of the Archives of Traditional Music. This collection consists of Smith's papers and lectures, dissertations of some of his students, correspondence, committee files, and some classroom materials. Prominent in the papers are Smith's files on the Folklore Institute and department, such as teaching files, meeting minutes, and curriculum reviews. (2 cubic feet)

Frank N. Young papers, 1930-1995, Collection C153: Frank N. Young was a professor of zoology and biology at Indiana University. His research and teaching interests included ecology, entomology, and parasitology, but much of his work focused specifically on water beetles. Collection consists of correspondence, research files, publications, including his dissertation *The water beetles of Florida*, committee files, and teaching files. (12 cubic feet)

Hubert C. Heffner papers, 1919-1978, Collection C296: Hubert C. Heffner was a Distinguished Professor Emeritus of Speech, Theatre, and Dramatic Literature at Indiana University. After teaching at several institutions across the United States and England, he settled in Bloomington in 1955. In addition to his teaching responsibilities within the Dept. of Speech and Theatre, Heffner was acting director of the Indiana University Theatre from 1959-60 and 1970-71, and he was involved with the Indiana Theatre Circle. He retired in 1971 but continued as an occasional guest lecturer at IUB until his death in 1985. The collection consists of lecture notes, classroom handouts and teaching aids,

Heffner's correspondence and personal writings, book reviews written by Heffner and files on various organizations to which he belonged throughout his career. Prominent in the teaching materials are Heffner's files on drama, especially American drama, and individual playwrights. (10 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/063: University Reporting & Research - "Year Book" files containing detailed statistics for student enrollment and the faculty body from 1916-1944. Information included are rosters for particular schools, including the Biological Station and Indianapolis programs; African American enrollment and graduation lists; and enrollment by Indiana counties, etc. (1.8 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/065: Papers of Rosan A. Jordan (PhD Folklore, 1975) - papers include Dr. Jordan's research materials, teaching files, and correspondence. (2 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/073: Indiana Memorial Union - records dating from Winston Shindell's tenure as IMU Director; primarily chronological correspondence files (1980-2000) but also includes a guest book from the Memorial room (1962-1987), and banquets and reservation logs (1991-1994). (approx. 10 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/077: Papers of Joan Sterrenburg, Professor Emeritus of Fine Arts - Papers include brochures and catalogs for exhibits, Dr. Sterrenburg's dossier, as well as samples of paper, slides on the process of papermaking, and related publications. (3 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/085: Indiana Memorial Union - administrative records spanning 1955-1989; prominent files include information on the IMU renovations. (4 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/087: Dept. of Folklore and Ethnomusicology - student papers (2005-2006) to be added to the Folklore Collection. (1 cubic foot)

Accession 2007/091: University Counsel - general litigation files, 1966-2003. Closed to researchers at this time. (13 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/096: President's office - Committee files. (1.8 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/100: Office of Summer Sessions and Special Programs - Publications and photographs. (7 cubic feet)

Accession 2007/101: President's office - Speeches of President Adam W. Herbert, 2003-2007. (2 cubic feet)
