Although many worry that libraries are not as popular amongst younger generations, a new [Pew Research Center report](#) released a few weeks ago indicates otherwise. The report, entitled "Younger Americans' Library Habits and Expectations" shows that 16-29 year-olds are still engaged with libraries -- and not just with technology like e-books. The report states that the "under-30 age group remains anchored in the digital age, but retains a strong relationship with print media and an affinity for libraries. Moreover, younger Americans have a broad understanding of what a library is and can be—a place for accessing printed books as well as digital resources, that remains at its core a physical
