Faculty Marshals indicate to the candidates they should stand.

The Platform Party members walk to their chairs and remain  
standing. The GRAND MARSHAL moves to the side microphone.)

GRAND MARSHAL WALDMAN: **PRESIDENT EHRLICH,**

**CHANCELLOR COHEN, THE CANDIDATES ARE**

**ASSEMBLED. ► WE MAY NOW PROCEED WITH**

**THESE COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES.**

(The GRAND MARSHAL peaks his cap. The PRESIDENT and CHANCELLOR COHEN return the gesture. The GRAND MARSHAL moves to his chair and remains standing. The PRESIDENT moves to the lectern microphone.)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,**

**WELCOME. ► AS WE BEGIN THIS COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY, WE WILL BE LED IN SINGING THE NATIONAL ANTHEM BY ROBERT W. DEMAREE, JR., DEAN, DIVISION OF THE ARTS AND PROFESSOR OF MUSIC. ► GLENN F. CHESNUT, PROFESSOR OF HISTORY, WILL OFFER THE INVOCATION. ► (If audience is seated.) PLEASE STAND.**

(The PRESIDENT returns to his chair, doffs cap, and remains standing.)

(All doff caps.)

(NATIONAL ANTHEM

(PRESIDENT EHRLICH steps to the lectern.)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: PLEASE BE SEATED. ► LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, MEMBERS OF THE CLASS OF 1992, WELCOME TO THE 163RD ANNUAL COMMENCEMENT CEREMONIES OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY AND THE TWENTY-SIXTH COMMENCEMENT EXERCISE ON THIS CAMPUS. ► ESPECIALLY I WELCOME THE PARENTS, WIVES, HUSBANDS, AND OTHER RELATIVES WHO HAVE HELPED MAKE POSSIBLE THIS DAY OF ACHIEVEMENT FOR OUR CANDIDATES. ► WE SHARE THEIR PRIDE IN THIS CELEBRATION OF ACCOMPLISHMENT.**

PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns the gesture and resumes seat.)

LAMON AND CHANCELLOR EMERITUS LESTER M.

(CHANCELLOR leads applause.)

**SEATED ON THE PLATFORM WE ARE HONORED TO HAVE  
WITH US ALSO MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF  
ADVISORS OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY AT SOUTH BEND.**

**► I ASK THEM TO STAND FOR OUR GREETING.**

(CHANCELLOR leads applause, and resumes seat.)

(ALUMNI INDUCTION CEREMONY)

(PRESIDENT EHRLICH moves to lectern.)

**PRESIDENT EHRLICH: WE WILL NOW OBSERVE THE  
TRADITIONAL CEREMONIES INDUCTING THE MEMBERS  
OF THE GRADUATING CLASSES INTO THEIR  
RESPECTIVE ALUMNI ASSOCIATIONS.**

**I INVITE CARLTON C. POTTS, ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF THE  
PURDUE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, TO INDUCT THE  
PURDUE CANDIDATES.**

(MR. POTTS rises, peaks cap, and moves to the lectern.)

PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns the gesture and resumes seat.)

**MR. POTTS: WILL THE PURDUE CANDIDATES PLEASE  
STAND. ► ON BEHALF OF THE MORE THAN 270,000  
PURDUE ALUMNI THROUGHOUT THE WORLD, PLEASE  
ACCEPT MY SINCERE CONGRATULATIONS ON THE  
COMPLETION OF AN IMPORTANT PART OF YOUR  
FORMAL EDUCATION.**



**AS YOU RECEIVE YOUR DEGREES, YOU BECOME PART OF  
A PROUD TRADITION. ► FROM THE VASTNESS OF  
OUTER SPACE, WHERE PURDUE GRADUATES NEIL  
ARMSTRONG AND EUGENE CERNAN WERE THE FIRST  
AND LAST MEN TO WALK ON THE MOON, TO THE  
INNER WORKINGS OF THE CELL, WHERE PURDUE  
SCIENTISTS PIONEERED DNA RESEARCH, THE QUEST  
FOR KNOWLEDGE BEGUN BY A PURDUE EDUCATION IS  
VAST AND WORLD-SHAKING. ► PURDUE ALUMNI  
ARE LEADERS. ► THEY ASPIRE TO ACHIEVEMENT.  
► WHEREVER PURDUE IS FOUND, SO ALSO IS

THE UNIVERSITY. ► H. WILLIAM GILMORE, VICE-  
PRESIDENT OF THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY ALUMNI  
ASSOCIATION, WILL REPRESENT THE ALUMNI.  
► PAMELA LYNN KERTES, PRESIDENT OF THE**

**STUDENT ALUMNI COUNCIL, WILL REPRESENT THE  
CLASS.**

**WILL THE MEMBERS OF THE IU GRADUATING CLASS**

**PLEASE STAND AND REMAIN STANDING UNTIL AFTER  
WE SING THE ALMA MATER SONG, "HAIL TO OLD I.U."**

(MR. TODD, DEAN GILMORE, and MS. KERTES rise, peak caps,  
and proceed to the lectern and remain standing during the  
ceremony. PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns the gesture and  
resumes seat.)

MS. KERTES (addressing MR. TODD): **TRUSTEE TODD,**

**INSCRIBED UPON THIS SCROLL ARE THE NAMES OF  
EVERY MEMBER OF THE IUSB GRADUATING CLASS OF  
1992. ► I REQUEST THAT EACH NAME BE FORMALLY  
ADDED TO THE LIST OF ALUMNI OF INDIANA  
UNIVERSITY.**

(MS. KERTES hands scroll to MR. TODD, who steps forward to  
receive it.)

MS. KERTES continues: **WE PLEDGE OUR CONTINUING ALLEGIANCE AND ASK THE ALUMNI BODY TO DIRECT OUR SERVICE.**

MR. TODD: **THANK YOU, PAM.** (addressing DEAN GILMORE): **VICE PRESIDENT GILMORE, THE TRUSTEES OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY PRESENT TO YOU FOR ADMISSION INTO THE BODY OF ALUMNI THESE CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES, MEMBERS OF THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 1992. ► THESE MEN AND WOMEN WILL BE THE UNIVERSITY'S REPRESENTATIVES IN MANY FIELDS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. ► WE HOPE THAT THEIR WORK WILL REFLECT HONOR UPON AND BRING GREATER STRENGTH TO OUR UNIVERSITY.**

(MR. TODD hands scroll to DEAN GILMORE, who steps forward to receive it.)

DEAN GILMORE (addressing MR. TODD): **TRUSTEE TODD, WE ACCEPT INTO THE FELLOWSHIP OF ALUMNI THESE**

**CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES FROM INDIANA  
UNIVERSITY.**

DEAN GILMORE (addressing the candidates): **MEMBERS OF  
THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 1992, WE WELCOME YOU  
TO THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION AND WE WISH YOU  
WELL. ► THE STRENGTH OF THE ASSOCIATION AND  
THIS UNIVERSITY DEPENDS ON THE STRENGTH OF  
EACH OF YOU.**

**THE ALUMNI JOIN YOU IN YOUR PLEDGE OF SUPPORT FOR  
A UNIVERSITY COMMITTED TO GREATER SERVICE TO  
HUMANKIND.**

(IU representatives return to their seats and remain standing, and  
PRESIDENT EHRLICH moves to the lectern.)

PRESIDENT EHRLICH: **TO THE NEWEST INDIANA  
UNIVERSITY ALUMNI, I OFFER CONGRATULATIONS ON  
YOUR INDUCTION INTO THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY  
ALUMNI ASSOCIATION. ► IN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF**



(PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns to the lectern and doffs cap.)

(CHARGE TO THE CLASS)

(PRESIDENT EHRLICH dons cap and resumes seat.

CHANCELLOR COHEN returns to lectern.)

(CONFERRAL OF PURDUE DEGREES)

**CHANCELLOR COHEN: WE NOW COME TO THE CENTRAL  
MOMENT OF THESE CEREMONIES, THE CONFERRAL OF  
DEGREES. ► CANDIDATES WHO BY VOTE OF THE  
FACULTY HAVE BEEN AWARDED HONORS IN GENERAL  
SCHOLARSHIP ARE DISTINGUISHED BY HONOR CORDS  
IN INDIANA'S CREAM AND CRIMSON AND PURDUE'S  
OLD GOLD AND BLACK. ► IN YOUR PROGRAM YOU  
WILL FIND UNDER THE SECTION "HONORS" HOW TO  
IDENTIFY THESE OUTSTANDING MEMBERS OF THE  
CLASS.**

**THE UNIVERSITIES ARE PROUD OF ALL THEIR GRADUATES  
AND TAKE AN ADDED MEASURE OF PRIDE IN THOSE  
WHO HAVE EXCELLED ACADEMICALLY; THEREFORE, I  
ASK THE CANDIDATES GRADUATING WITH "HIGHEST**

STANDING. (pause)**

**WILL THE CANDIDATES GRADUATING WITH "HIGH  
DISTINCTION" PLEASE STAND. (pause)**

**WILL THE CANDIDATES GRADUATING WITH "DISTINCTION"  
PLEASE STAND. (pause-leads applause). ► PLEASE BE  
SEATED.**

(DEAN GENTRY and DR. PERUSICH rise, peak caps, and move to lectern. CHANCELLOR COHEN returns the gesture and resumes seat. DEAN GENTRY stands at lectern; DR. PERUSICH stands at side microphone.)

**DR. PERUSICH: WILL THE CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE  
ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE IN COMPUTER  
INTEGRATED MANUFACTURING TECHNOLOGY PLEASE  
STAND.**

**WILL THE CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE ASSOCIATE OF  
APPLIED SCIENCE IN COMPUTER PROGRAMMING  
TECHNOLOGY PLEASE STAND.**

**WILL THE CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE ASSOCIATE OF

DEGREE. ► AS EVIDENCE OF THIS DEGREE AND  
YOUR ABILITY TO FULFILL ITS OBLIGATIONS, YOU WILL

(DEAN GENTRY and DR. PERUSICH resume seats and  
CHANCELLOR COHEN moves to side lectern.)

**CHANCELLOR COHEN: THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY**

**CANDIDATES WILL BE PRESENTED BY THE DEANS,  
CHAIRPERSONS AND DIRECTORS OF THE ACADEMIC

**DEAN SNYDER: MR. PRESIDENT, THIS CANDIDATE,

**DR. HENGESBACH: WILL THE CANDIDATES FOR THE DEGREE ASSOCIATE OF GENERAL STUDIES PLEASE STAND.**
