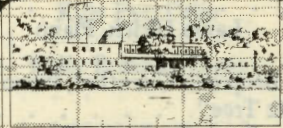

In the fall of 1986, the IUSB Music Academy was formed to offer quality music instruction for all ages to the South Bend and surrounding regional communities. The Academy offers non-credit class instruction beginning with age two through adult, and studio lessons in all instruments.

A large portion of the Academy student enrollment is in the Suzuki string and piano program, where students of all ages and their parents participate in an environment which teaches creative, musical skills on stringed instruments.
