Need monetary support for research or research-related activities? The InULA Grants Fund is intended to encourage and support research by providing funding for projects of any size or scope. Grant applications are now being accepted through January 15, 2020. Guidelines and application information can be found at: http://www.indiana.edu/~inula/wp_2012/inula-research-incentive-fund-guidelines/. You must be a current member of InULA to be eligible. The InULA Grants and Scholarship Committee will review grant applications using a newly-revised rubric. In the case of equally meritorious proposals, those of non-tenured librarians may be given priority because it is often difficult for beginning researchers to obtain research grants. Recommendations will then be made to the InULA Executive Board for approval and funding. Notice of awards is provided to applicants as soon as possible. Can't

It is with great sadness that I announce the upcoming departure of Associate Librarian, Craig Finlay. He has accepted a library director position at Murray State College, a public community college in southeastern Oklahoma. His last day is Friday, January 31.

We are very appreciative for all the amazing work that Craig has done to move the library and campus forward in the areas of scholarly communication, open access, journal publishing, and copyright consultation over the last 6-1/2 years. Not only does IU South Bend have a robust open institutional repository that includes faculty and student research as well as all masters' theses, Craig worked with the Student Publications Committee to set up journal hosting for all student publications. He also led an important open education resources (OER) initiative on campus that included a five-week faculty summer institute and special grants in the fall for writing open educational textbooks. Last year, Craig was instrumental in the passing of an open access policy—the first regional campus to do so in the IU system. Along with his many contributions the library's instruction and subject librarian program, Craig has solid service record, garnering state and national recognition for starting the first conference devoted to scholarly communication and working with the new CERES office to resurrect the *IUSB Review*. During his tenure at IU South Bend, he published eight scholarly articles. Craig brought a fierce energy, creative spirit, and sense of humor that will be difficult to replace.
