- 1) TJ Rivard reported that UFC has ended the ECAP policy due to IUB resistance. We discussed whether to renig our policy but decided to keep it for the moment since most of the items had be required before anyway. We do need to consider the work involved for the faculty member, however, particularly needing to contact campuses, although we can possibly use our secretaries to contact campuses for sample syllabi.

- 2) Jerome Mahaffey's Communication Courses
 - All needed pre-requisites specified in Question #2 (or lack thereof)
 - J110: is this appropriate as a 100 level course since it is a "concentration elective"? Open to non-majors? How about deleting the word "concentration" so that is reads "as an elective for the major"?
 - J219: will this replace SPCH 333 or will both be listed on the Mastor Course list? How about cross-listing so this will not impact other programs?
 - C380 and C304: replacing speech courses? Any pre-requisites?
 - T206 looked OK
 - Alisa will suggest these changes to Jerome
 - We will show this on overhead at the next Senate meeting, Apr. 30

- 3) NSM proposal: to realign the math sequence along the lines of sequences on other campuses
 - M117 will replace M014—it is like M117 on other campuses—will not count for distribution credit
 - Peggy will clarify sequence charts
 - Peggy or other NSM representative will speak at Senate: all programs will need to make these changes to their math requirements
